THIS WEEK FOR THE COWGIRLS: NORTH DAKOTA STATE

<u>Home Opener against the Bison:</u> After opening the 2016 season at the Purdue Mortar Board Premier, Wyoming is set to host North Dakota State for its home opener on Monday evening. The Cowgirls return to Laramie in search of their first win of the 2016 season, after a 0-3 start in West Lafayette, Ind., this past weekend. UW fell to No. 20 Purdue and No. 24 Kentucky in straight sets, before another hard fought match and four-set loss against Washington State.

Nice to See You Again: It will be the first time since 2004 that the Cowgirls have played North Dakota State. UW holds the all-time series advantage, 1-0, having swept the Bison at home on Sept. 27, 2004.

<u>Starting Fast:</u> With Chad Callihan as head coach, the Cowgirls have gone 10-3 in the month of August. After sweeping the Rumble in the Rockies tournament a year ago, UW went 4-0 in the UniWyo Wyoming Invite in 2013, and 3-0 at the Montana Invite last season.

<u>Home Sweet Home</u>: Success on their home court is nothing new for the current Cowgirls. Dating back to the 2013 season, Wyoming has won 84 percent of its matches in Laramie, sporting a record of 41-8.

<u>All-Tournament Team:</u> Junior Lily Austin was named to the All-Tournament team at the Purdue Mortar Board Premier. She played in all ten sets and led UW with 42 digs (4.20 per set) on the weekend.

NDSU was picked to finish second in the Summit League coaches preseason poll. The Bison only lost one starter from a year ago, and return two all-league honorable mention honorees in Emily Minnick and Emily Miron. Minnick and Miron finished second and third, respectively, for the Bison in both kills and kills per set in 2015.

The Bison are led by senior outside hitter Hadley Steffen with 30 kills, and senior middle blocker Emily Minnick with 28. Junior setter Brianna Rasmusson has 82 total assists and an average of 6.83 per set. Defensively, senior defensive specialist Emily Milligan has a team-high 37 digs, while Minnick and Miron each have eight blocks for NDSU.

MW Preseason Poll: The Wyoming volleyball team was selected to finish third, as the Mountain West announced the 2016 preseason volleyball poll. The voting panel consisted of the league's 11 head coaches. Defending league-champion Colorado State was chosen as the favorite to win the 2016 MW regular-season title.

Offering Assistance: As a junior, Courtney Chacon became just the ninth Cowgirl in school history to record at least 2,000 career assists. For her career, she is eighth all-time with 2,426 assists and led UW last season.

<u>Double-Trouble:</u> Junior Kayla Slofkiss finished second in the league with 14 double-doubles last season. She led Wyoming as junior Courtney Chacon had ten, freshman Cori Aafedt had two and senior's Bridget Shanahan and Allison Waldvogel each had one.

Hard Block Cafe: Middle blocker Reed Copeland was named the 2015 MW Freshman of the Year after not only leading the MW but the NCAA in blocks and blocks per set. Copeland had a nation-high 190 blocks and an average of 1.68 blocks per set. She was the only freshman to be in the top-30 of both categories. As a team, the Cowgirls finished at the top of the MW in blocks per set and were sixth in the NCAA with 3.01. Wyoming was first in the MW in total blocks and finished eighth in the NCAA with 349 blocks.

<u>Life's a Beach:</u> Laura Beach has found herself atop the list in all-time hitting percentage for a Cowgirl. After hitting .337 last season and currently hitting .304 this year, Beach has a .359 hitting percentage for her career. She ended her junior campaign ranked 107th in the NCAA in hitting percentage.

MW RPI Rankings: Aided by a tough nonconference schedule and a 16-2 record at home, the 2015 Cowgirl volleyball team claimed the 42nd spot in the final NCAA RPI's Rankings, released on Dec. 21.
