THIS WEEK FOR THE COWGIRLS: SPORTS IMPORTS D.C. KOEHL CLASSIC

Weekend Getaway to Columbus: UW will travel to the 12th Annual Sports Imports D.C. Koehl Classic this weekend, hosted by the Ohio State University. In Columbus, Wyoming will face off against two NCAA Regional teams in Ohio State and BYU, in addition to LIU Brooklyn. In the 2015 volleyball championship, the Buckeyes fell to then-No. 1 Washington in five sets, while the Cougars lost to eventual champion Nebraska.

Nice to See You Again: It will be first meeting with old rival BYU since 2010. The Cougars won the last matchup between the two teams, as they came away with a five set victory in Laramie.

Starting Fast: With Chad Callihan as head coach, the Cowgirls have gone 10-3 in the month of August. After sweeping the Rumble in the Rockies tournament a year ago, UW went 4-0 in the UniWyo Wyoming Invite in 2013, and 3-0 at the Montana Invite last season.

Home Sweet Home: Success on their home court is nothing new for the current Cowgirls. Dating back to the 2013 season, Wyoming has won 84 percent of its matches in Laramie, sporting a record of 42-8.

All-Tournament Team: Junior Lily Austin was named to the All-Tournament team at the Purdue Mortar Board Premier. She played in all ten sets and led UW with 42 digs (4.20 per set) during the weekend. On the season, Austin has a team-high 52 digs and is tied seventh in the MW with an average of 4.00 digs per set.

Offering Assistance: As a junior, Courtney Chacon became just the ninth Cowgirl in school history to record at least 2,000 career assists. For her career, she is eighth all-time with 2,458 assists and led UW last season. So far this season, Chacon is seventh in the MW with 100 assists and an average of 7.69 assists per set.

Life's a Beach: Laura Beach has found herself atop the list in all-time hitting percentage for a Cowgirl. After hitting .337 last season and currently hitting .362 this year, Beach has a .360 hitting percentage for her career. She is currently tenth in the MW with her .362 hitting percentage.

Preseason All-MW Team: UW senior Laura Beach was named to the seven-person preseason all-conference team. Beach earned All-MW honors for the second time a year ago. Boise State junior Sierra Nobley was named the 2016 MW Preseason Player of the Year.

MW Preseason Poll: The Wyoming volleyball team was selected to finish third, as the Mountain West announced the 2016 preseason volleyball poll. The voting panel consisted of the league's 11 head coaches. Defending league-champion Colorado State was chosen as the favorite to win the 2016 MW regular-season title.

Double-Trouble: Junior Kayla Slofkiss finished second in the league with 14 double-doubles last season. She led Wyoming as junior Courtney Chacon had ten, freshman Cori Aafedt had two and senior's Bridget Shanahan and Allison Waldvogel each had one.

Hard Block Cafe: Middle blocker Reed Copeland was named the 2015 MW Freshman of the Year after not only leading the MW but the NCAA in blocks and blocks per set. Copeland had a nation-high 190 blocks and an average of 1.68 blocks per set. She was the only freshman to be in the top-30 of both categories. As a team, the Cowgirls finished at the top of the MW in blocks per set and were sixth in the NCAA with 3.01. Wyoming was first in the MW in total blocks and finished eighth in the NCAA with 349 blocks.
