UW Hit's the Road for the Gem State: The Cowgirl volleyball team will close the nonconference portion of its schedule this weekend at the Idaho Volleyball Classic. UW will start with host Idaho at 5:30 p.m. MT on Friday, and then Oregon State at 11 a.m. and Tennessee Tech at 5:30 p.m. on Saturday.

All-Time Series: Thursday's match with the Vandals marks the tenth matchup between the schools. Idaho leads the all-time series, 7-2, as Oregon State has a 5-1 lead over UW. The match against Tennessee Tech will be the first for Wyoming.

All-Tournament Team: Sophomore Reed Copeland was the tournament MVP at the UniWyo Invite this last weekend. Seniors Courtney Chacon and Laura Beach were also honored for their stellar play. Junior Lily Austin was named to the All-Tournament team at the Purdue Mortar Board Premier, as redshirt freshman Bayly Poor was the lone representative named to the All-Tournament team at the Sports Imports D.C. Koehl Classic.

Offering Assistance: As a junior, Courtney Chacon became just the ninth Cowgirl in school history to record at least 2,000 career assists. For her career, she is now seventh all-time with 2,618 assists. So far this season, Chacon is ninth in the MW with 260 assists and an average of 7.82 assists per set.

Life's a Beach: Laura Beach sits at the top of the list in all-time hitting percentage as a Cowgirl. After hitting .337 last season and currently hitting a team-best .444 this year, Beach has a .368 hitting percentage for her career. She is also currently leading the MW with her .444 hitting percentage.

Double-Trouble: Courtney Chacon recorded her first double-double of the 2016 season during the UniWyo Invite. Against Samford, Chacon recorded 25 assists and 11 digs to begin Wyoming's lone non-conference home tournament. At the time, it also marked the sixth time this season she had at least 20 assists. Additionally, Chacon has led the Cowgirls in assists in all ten matches this season.

Closing In On 300: Chad Callihan currently has 299 career wins as a head coach. His 72 wins at Wyoming are third most in program history, and the 36 conference wins are also third best for a UW head coach.

Hard Block Cafe: Middle blocker Reed Copeland was named the 2015 MW Freshman of the Year after not only leading the MW but the NCAA in blocks and blocks per set. Copeland has continued leading UW defensively so far this season. She has 31 total blocks (1.00 bps) through the first ten matches and has led the Cowgirls in blocks in five different matches.

Can You Dig it?: Junior Lily Austin has recorded at least 15 digs in five matches this season. She is ninth in the MW with an average of 3.58 per set and has a total of 111 through the first ten matches. Austin also leads UW with nine service aces.

Preseason All-MW Team: UW senior Laura Beach was named to the seven-person preseason all-conference team. Beach earned All-MW honors for the second time a year ago. Boise State junior Sierra Nobley was named the 2016 MW Preseason Player of the Year.
