OPENING KICKOFF

• UC Davis returns to the road, facing its second FBS opponent this year and looking for its first win over an FBS team since beating San Jose State in 2010... It's 2-15 vs. FBS teams since 2005.

• Both FBS teams on this year's schedule are first-time opponents for the Aggies... UC Davis has never played a team from Wyoming.

• The Aggies will be trying to turn a road tide that has them 2-11 away from home since the start of the 2014 season.

• RB MANUSAMOA LUUGA's 90-yard touchdown run last Saturday against Southern Oregon is the longest in either the FBS or FCS so far this season and is T-2nd on Aggies' all-time list... His 5 TDs on the ground this season are also FCS-leading... Luuga's long run also upped his carry average to a Big Sky-leading 6.9 yards while his 241 yards are second in the league.

• QB BEN SCOTT, with back-to-back 300-yard games, is ranked second nationally with a 342.0 avg... He's also second in passing yards (684), fifth in total offense (336.0) and in the top 20 in four other categories... Scott's thrown consecutive 300-yard games twice in his career after also doing so in 2014.

• The Aggies have benefitted from seven opponent turnovers, have just one themselves (int vs. Oregon) and are T-1st nationally in turnover margin (3.0 avg)... They're just one of 27 teams not to lose a fumble yet this year.

• UC Davis' four interceptions – all coming against Southern Oregon – are one more than it had all of last season and are sixth-best in the FCS in 2016.

• Yes, it's early, but through two games, the Aggies are averaging 157.5 ypg. on the ground which is significantly higher than the 121.8 they ground out in 2015... Their passing yards (347.0 pg) and total offense (504.5 ypg.) are ranked fourth and 10th, respectively, among all FCS teams.

• WR RAMON VARGAS' 208 receiving yards against Southern Oregon are third-most in the FCS this year and marked the first 200-yard game for UC Davis since WR TONY KAYS set the school record (233) in 2001.

• The Aggies' 80 points is their best showing in a season's first two games since scoring 88 against South Dakota State (57) and Weber State (31) in 2004.

• UC Davis started two true freshmen against the Raiders last weekend... WR JARED HARRELL caught four passes for 24 yards while DT BRYCE RODGERS helped stifle things in the trenches for the defense.

LAST MEETING

• The Aggies and Cowboys have never met in football nor has UC Davis played any college team from Wyoming.
• UC Davis, however, has played five games against Mountain West Conference teams (Nevada, 0-2; Hawai'i, 0-1; Colorado State, 0-1; TCU, 0-1)... The Aggies have also faced current MWC members San Jose State, Boise State and Fresno State when those schools were members of the Western Athletic Conference.

SCOTT HITS 300.... AGAIN!

• QB BEN SCOTT completed 22 of 29 passes for a career-high 381 yards against Southern Oregon last weekend... It was the fourth 300-yard game of his career, his second in a row and the second time he's done it in back-to-back games (vs. Montana State, Montana in '14).
• As noted, he ranks second in the FCS in passing yards (684), passing ypg. (342.0) and fifth in total offense (336.0 ypg)... He's also 10th in yards per attempt (9.0), 11th in yards per completion (13.9), 16th in passing TDs (4) and 17th in passing efficiency (154.8)... Thanks to QB GAGE GUBRUD of Eastern Washington who is the FCS's top thrower right now, Scott does not lead the Big Sky in most stats.
• His yards last weekend eclipsed the 379 he had against Montana State in his first career start in 2014 and are ranked T-21st on the all-time list.
• Scott's 20.4 completions per game in his career ranks fifth among active FCS quarterbacks while his career passing efficiency (141.4) is 10th.

LUUGA RUSHING TO GET AROUND

• Two games into his senior season, RB MANUSAMOA LUUGA is off to his best start as an Aggie... With 241 rushing yards, he's more than a third of the way to the career-best 613 yards he had all of last year.
• His 5 TDs – ranked first nationally – are just one shy of his 2015 total and more than half of the nine he had entering this season.
• Luuga is ranked seventh in the FCS for rushing yards, rushing ypg. (120.5) and all-purpose yards (175.0 pg.), and is 12th for yards per carry (6.7).
• He had his first career 100-yard game in last season's finale against Sacramento State (24-17) but now has two after rushing for 145 on 13 carries last week... Luuga (96 yds) was just shy at Oregon.

VARGAS JOINS ELITE CATCH CORPS

• Senior WR RAMON VARGAS had 284 receiving yards last year but went a long way to reaching that last Saturday alone when he caught six passes for a career-best 208 yards.
• Included was a career-long 65-yard TD reception from Scott in the third quarter and then a 64-yard catch early in the fourth.
• Vargas' 208 yards rank fourth all-time for a single game in Aggie history, just in front of former UC Davis tight end (and Oregon head coach) MIKE BELLOTTI (204 vs. Humboldt State, '72).
• Vargas picked up his yardage on just six catches... His 34.7 avg. trails only CALVIN ELLISON's 38.2 avg. (6-229) against Puget Sound in 1978 as best among 200-yard receivers.

TURNOVERS OFF TO HOT START

• The Aggies benefitted from just 11 turnovers in 2015 (8 fum, 3 int.) and were -5 overall... Already, however, UC Davis has dramatically turned the

Media Services

PRACTICE DAY INTERVIEWS - Media are requested to provide at least 24 hours notice to help ensure player/coach availability and to confirm practice times. Players will return phone calls when requested. Home phone numbers will not be given out under any circumstance. Players are not available before practice and are available post-practice unless class schedules conflict.

PRACTICE LOCATION - The Aggies practice Tuesday through Fridays at Aggie Stadium. Parking is available in Lot 56, adjacent to the south end of the stadium. Park in non-metered spots and place a media business card on dashboard.

HOME GAME CREDENTIALS - Credentials must be requested by noon on Thursday prior to each home game. Credentials will be left at Media Will Call entrance on west side of Aggie Stadium (entrance behind pressbox). Media covering the Aggies on a weekly basis will be provided season credentials. Media with sideline credentials must stay outside of 25-yard lines.

PRESSBOX SERVICES - Statistics will be provided each quarter along with a full stats packet at the end of the game. Game programs and other info will also be provided. Depth charts will be updated prior to the game. Media guides are available on the athletics website. Food and beverages will also be available.

GAMEDAY PARKING - General media parking is in Lot 53 (at UC Davis Genome Center) which is located approximately a three-minute walk from the west entrance to Aggie Stadium. Credentialed media will have names on a list with parking lot attendants.

HOME POSTGAME INTERVIEWS - Requested UC Davis players and coaches will be available for interviews 15 minutes after conclusion of the game. Interviews will be conducted in the Bruce Edwards Club Room and coordinated by UC Davis Athletics Communications. Opponent interviews are at the discretion of the visiting SID but will likely be held near the team's lockerroom or on the field. Locker rooms are not open to the media.

ON THE ROAD - Asst. AD/Communications Mike Robles travels with the Aggies and can help arrange player/coach interviews. No interviews will be granted on gameday prior to kickoff. He can be reached on the road via cell at (530) 979-1747.

tide by picking up seven turnovers.

- The Aggies grabbed three fumbles against Oregon, including two of them on special teams, and then added four interceptions against Southern Oregon.

- They ranked last in the FCS in interceptions last year but this year are No. 6 in the early going.
- UC Davis is T-1st in turnover margin (3.0 avg.) with just a single interception against Oregon on the miscue chart.

- The Aggies are just one of 27 teams not to lose a fumble yet this season. *(knock on wood)*

THE FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH

- The Aggies are making sure their younger players are in the mix from the start... A total off 11 players on the two-deep are seeing their first collegiate action, including two true freshmen who are first on the depth chart: WR JARED HARRELL and DT BRYCE ROGERS.

- Additionally, a true freshman - MATT BLAIR - has taken on place-kicking duties for UC Davis, replacing graduated senior BRADY STUART who set a school record with 51 career field goals.

- Of the 45 offensive and defensive names on the depth chart, 20 are occupied by underclassmen.

SCHNEIDER CHANGES SIDES

- OL CHRISTIAN SCHNEIDER made a home at right tackle over his first three seasons, including in 2013 as a true freshman... Since then, the 6-6, 315-pounder has started all but one game he's played (31 of 32).

- This season, Schneider jumps to the opposite side to play left tackle, taking over for graduated senior PARKER SMITH, who was moved there last year to replace 2014 senior IAN JOSEPH - a four-year starter.

WADMAN THE WEAPON

- P COLBY WADMAN had big shoes to fill when school-record holder COLTON SCHMIDT finished in 2012... He is now the punter for the Buffalo Bills... But, Wadman has done just fine, thank you, and is on his way to also becoming one of the program's all-time bests.

- Through three seasons, Wadman is averaging 40.2 yards per kick and ranks third all-time.

- Wadman averaged 40.6 yards last season, had a best of 61 yards, kicked 13 over 50 yards, had 22 of 57 total result in fair catches and landed 17 inside the 20.

- He punted eight times in the opener for a 43.2 avg. and last week put 4 of 6 kicks inside the 20.

- Wadman was named All-Big Sky honorable mention as a sophomore in 2014.

PRESEASON POLLS

- UC Davis was selected 23th by the head coaches and 12th by the media in the Big Sky's preseason polls released in July.
- Northern Arizona, which lost to UC Davis last season, was the pick by both the coaches and media to win the conference race this fall.
- No Aggies were selected to the 29-player Preseason All-Big Sky team.

GETTING IT DONE IN THE CLASSROOM

- The Aggies posted an NCAA Academic Progress Rate of 981 to lead the Big Sky Conference for the fourth consecutive year... The distinction earned them an APR Award from the FCS Athletics Directors Association for the fourth straight year.
- UC Davis has increased its APR each year during the impressive run and owns the second-longest active streak of APR Awards. (Bryant University has won five straight).
- The APR measures student-athlete retention and eligibility and helps provide a real-time mark of classroom performance.
- The Aggies also had an NCAA graduation success rate of 83 percent in the most recent report, marking the second straight year they've led the Big Sky in that measurement as well... For the record, the entire UC Davis athletics program had a graduation rate of 88 percent... The program has led the Big West four straight years and seven of eight since reclassifying to NCAA Div. I in 2007-08.

RETURN OF BOB FOSTER

- BOB FOSTER doesn't need to look far to see his name at Aggie Stadium since it adorns the Bob Foster Team Center on the north end... It's a fitting tribute to a defensive genius who was a longtime assistant coach under legendary coach JIM SOCHOR before continuing the program's success during his four-year run as head coach (1989-92).
- Foster has retired and unretired several times since then, turning up on the coaching staffs at Oregon, Cal and Colorado... But, he's returned to his alma mater in 2016 because he just can't stay away from the sport he dearly loves.
- He was a consultant to the coaching staff during spring practices but is now back as a full-fledged assistant coach with the defense.

GOULD PRODUCES RBs

- Head coach RON GOULD turned out a bevy of outstanding running backs during his 16-year career as an assistant/associate head coach at Cal prior to joining UC Davis in 2012.
- His former players form a 'who's who' of NFL standouts: Marshawn Lynch (Seattle), Shane Vereen (N.Y. Giants), Justin Forsett (Baltimore) and C.J. Anderson (Denver)... FB Will Ta'ufo'ou was most recently with Jacksonville... Retired RB Jahvid Best (Detroit) was another outstanding Cal player.
- Gould brought his expertise to UC Davis where he's already turned out one of the Aggies' all-time best with former RB GABE MANZANARES who gained 2,116 career yards, was named the Big Sky Newcomer of the Year in 2014 and twice earned all-conference recognition in 2013-14.
- The last three Super Bowl winners have had a Gould-coached running back. (Lynch, Vereen, Anderson)

A 16-year veteran of the California Golden Bears' coaching staff, Ron Gould became just the 16th head coach in the 100-year history of UC Davis football when he was named to the Aggies' top position on Dec. 17, 2012. He replaced Bob Biggs who finished his 20-year career as head coach following the 2012 season.

Gould's short tenure with the Aggies has been marked by highly respected recruiting classes, high academic achievements by his team and two wins in the Causeway Classic against rival Sacramento State.

One of the most highly regarded running back coaches in the country, Gould has mentored some of the top runners in the game. In fact, the last three Super Bowl winners have each had one of his proteges: C.J. Anderson (Denver Broncos), Shane Vereen (New England Patriots) and Marshawn Lynch (Seattle Seahawks). Additionally, Jahvid Best, who played for the Detroit Lions before retiring from the NFL, showcased his speed this summer in the Rio de Janeiro Olympics while competing in the 100-meters for Saint Lucia.

Recruiting is the cornerstone to every successful football program and Gould has already established himself as one of the top recruiters at the Football Championship Subdivision level after earning similar respect while at the Football Bowl Subdivision level at Cal.

That was evidenced by his most recent recruiting class in 2016, which was ranked No. 10 among all FCS teams (and tops in the Big Sky Conference) by Saturday Blitz, and No. 17 by Hero Sports (third-highest in the Big Sky). That came two years after his 15-player 2014 class was comprised of 12 players rated two stars by Scout.com.

While his leadership in recruiting is helping to establish an exciting future, his emphasis on academic achievement has yielded similar results in two measurements by the NCAA: Academic Progress Rate (APR) and Graduation Success Rate (GSR). For the past four years, UC Davis has led the Big Sky in APR. It's the second-longest active streak in the FCS. The Aggies also had a GSR of 83 percent in the most recent data released by the NCAA, marking the second straight year they've led the Big Sky in that area.

On the field, UC Davis has put together one of the most disciplined teams in the FCS. In 2015, the Aggies ranked third nationally in fewest penalties (45), fewest penalties per game (4.09), fewest penalty yards (382) and fewest penalty yards per game (34.7). Additionally, ball control moving the ball close to the goal line were strengths for UC Davis, which was ranked second in time of possession (34:37) and tied for fifth in red-zone efficiency (.906).

Gould's first season with the Aggies produced a tie for fourth place in the powerful Big Sky Conference, a run of five victories over UC Davis' final eight games, and a convincing 34-7 win over rival Sacramento State in Gould's first Causeway Classic. He highlighted his second year by reclaiming the Golden Horseshoe with a 48-35 win over rival Cal Poly.

Gould, 50, joined the Aggies after an impressive career Cal where he developed several of college football's top tailbacks over the past decade, a list that includes NFL players Lynch (Seattle Seahawks), Best (Detroit Lions), Vereen (New England Patriots), Justin Forsett (Houston Texans) and Will Ta'ufu'ou (Jacksonville Jaguars). Other players who got their start with Gould and later signed NFL contracts include Chris Manderino (Cincinnati) and Tarik Smith (Dallas Cowboys).

He didn't take long to place his stamp on the UC Davis running backs, helping guide transfer Gabe Manzanares to the program's best rushing total (1,285 yards) in more than a decade in 2013.

Manzanares went on to win Big Sky Newcomer of the Year honors while ranking among the conference and NCAA Div. I FCS leaders in several statistical categories. Manzanared was named to the All-Big Sky third team in 2014 while finishing with 2,116 career yards in just two seasons.

From 1997-2007, he was the running back coach before being elevated to associate head coach in 2008. He added running game coordinator duties beginning in 2011.

Gould was a candidate for the 2010 American Football Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year Award and has served NFL internships with the Atlanta Falcons, Arizona Cardinals, Green Bay Packers, Los Angeles Rams, San Francisco 49ers and St. Louis Rams.

A native of Scottsdale, Ariz., Gould played at defensive back at Scottsdale Community College in 1984-85 before earning an athletics scholarship to Wichita State. The Shockers later discontinued their program, leading him to Oregon where he played for the Ducks and earned his bachelor's degree in criminology.

GAME 1: No. 24/22 Oregon 53, UC Davis 28

Sept. 3 • Autzen Stadium (Eugene, Ore.) • Attendance: 53,817

UC Davis held strong against No. 24/22 Oregon during the first quarter of their season-opening matchup at Autzen Stadium on and then played tough the rest of the way before the Ducks posted a 53-28 win before 53,817 fans.

Senior Ben Scott threw for 303 yards and ran for a 9-yard touchdown that gave the Aggies an early 7-0 lead. Senior Manusamoa Luuga put a workman-like effort together, rushing for 96 yards and three touchdowns and catching four passes for 51 more.

Sophomore Keelan Doss, returning to the Aggies' lineup after redshirting last year because of injury, caught seven passes for 116 yards, including a long 50-yarder from Scott on UC Davis' first play of the second half that preceded a 20-yard TD run by Luuga.

UC Davis rolled up 392 yards in total offense, had three second-half scoring drives of at least 65 yards and held the ball for more than 37 minutes. The Aggies' special teams picked up a pair of turnovers, including a fumble that led to their first touchdown.



Dakota Prukop, who transferred to Oregon from Montana State, threw for 271 yards and three touchdowns while Royce Freeman's 87 rushing yards and two scores led the Ducks' 251-yard ground attack. Darren Carrington had 117 receiving yards and a touchdown on seven catches. UC Davis sacked Prukop three times.

UC Davis was not intimidated against one of the more storied programs of the past 30 years. After being stopped on its opening drive, the Aggies got the game's first break when Charles Nelson fumbled Wadman's 37-yard punt and Darryl Graham fell on it at the 33-yard line.

Facing a 3rd-and-8, UC Davis got down to the 4 when Scott hit freshman Jared Harrell for a 27-yard pass play. A penalty pushed the Aggies back to the 9 but Scott rolled right on the next play before scampering up the middle for his second career TD run.

The Ducks' had quick strike to start the third quarter, keyed by Freeman's 49-yard run to the 1-yard line, preceded Prukop's TD rush and made it 33-7 as Oregon capped 33 straight points.

Luuga capped two long drives with a pair of 1-yard touchdowns. The first came at the end of an 11-play, 65-yard drive in the third quarter while the second put an exclamation point on an 8-play, 75-yard drive in the fourth.

Freeman scored from five yards, Darren Carrington caught a 55-yard TD pass from Prukop and Tony Brooks-James ran in from 33 yards for the Ducks' remaining scores after halftime.

Safety Ryan Parenteau had eight tackles for the Aggies' defense while Zach Jones, Darryl Graham and Russell Reeder each had seven. Parenteau and Jones each forced fumbles while Graham had a fumble recovery.

Reeder, Keelen Culberson and Brandon Jamison each had sacks. Scott was only sacked twice, including just once after the opening play of the game.

UC Davis did not have any fumbles while Oregon had three, two which they lost.

GAME 2: UC Davis 52, Southern Oregon 35

Sept. 10 • Aggie Stadium (Davis, Calif.) • Attendance: 5,433

Quarterback Ben Scott threw for a career-high 381 yards and four touchdowns, Ramon Vargas had 208 receiving yards and Manusamoa Luuga had a 90-yard touchdown run as UC Davis beat Southern Oregon in a nonconference football game.

The teams combined for 1,260 yards of total offense; 653 for Southern Oregon an 617 for the Aggies. UC Davis, which tied its highest scoring output since tallying 55 against Iona in 2008, went over 600 yards for the first time since 2014 against Montana State (610).

Scott finished 22 of 29 while throwing touchdown passes to Keelan Doss, Nehemiah Winston, Ethan Hicks and a 65-yarder to Vargas. His 381 yards eclipsed the 379 he had in his first start against Montana State two years ago.

Vargas' receiving yards are the fourth-most in school history and marked the first 200-yard game for an Aggie receiver since Tony Kay's school-record 233 yards against Texas A&M-Kingsville in the 2001 NCAA Div. II playoffs.

Luuga had 13 carries for 145 yards, highlighted by his 90-yard TD run late in the first quarter that gave UC Davis a 21-14 lead. The long run is tied for the second-longest in program history and tied Joe Trombetta's 90-yarder against Western Washington in 2007 as the longest at Aggie Stadium.

Defensive end Anthony Baumgart had eight tackles, 2 TFLs and an interception to help lead the defense while linebacker Zach Jones had five tackles. UC Davis had four interceptions against Southern Oregon, eclipsing the three it had all of last year. Safeties Darryl Graham, Mitch Casas and Ryan Parenteau also had picks.

The Aggies erupted for 21 points in the first quarter and 35 by halftime. Their first-half scoring was their best since 38 against Winston-Salem State in 2009.

Luuga then electrified the 5,433 fans in attendance when he bolted through the line with a minute to go in the first and raced 90 yards for his career-best run. That surpassed his previous best of 46 yards against Nevada on his first collegiate rush in 2013.

Tied at 21-21 after Rey Vega raced 48 yards with 9:13 left in the first half for Southern Oregon, UC Davis took the lead for good when Scott threw it up at the left endzone pylon and Doss came down with it in traffic for the score. Luuga's run up the gut for 13 yards with 4:59 to go gave the Aggies a 35-21 halftime lead.

UC Davis took a 21-point lead midway through the third quarter when Vargas got behind the defense and Scott found him for a 65-yard score. It was the longest reception of his career, beating the 58-yarder he hauled in from Scott against Montana in 2014.

Freshman Matt Blair gave the Aggies their biggest lead of the game with his first career field goal from 29 yards. Fullback Ethan Hick's four-yard TD catch from Scott early in the fourth quarter – the first of his young Aggie career – rounded out UC Davis' scoring.

Besides their four interceptions, UC Davis also broke up four passes and had 8 TFLs. Half of Baumgart's eight total tackles were solo stops. He returned his interception 15 yards.
