UW Back in Action for MW Play: The Cowgirl volleyball team will open Mountain West play this week as San Jose State and Fresno State make their way to Laramie. The match against the Spartans will begin at 6:30 p.m. MT on Thursday, while the Bulldogs and Cowgirls will meet up at 1 p.m. on Saturday

All-Time Series: Wyoming split with SJSU last season, and holds a 6-4 all-time advantage. In the six home matches against the Spartans, UW has come away victorious in the last three. Wyoming won its lone match with Fresno State in 2015. UW leads the all-time series, 16-10 and has won the last four matches against the Bulldogs.

All-Tournament Team: In the last nonconference tournament, senior Courtney Chacon and sophomore Emily Lewis were named to the all-tournament team. Sophomore Reed Copeland was the tournament MVP at the UniWyo Invite, as Chacon and Laura Beach were also honored for their stellar play. Junior Lily Austin was named to the All-Tournament team at the Purdue Mortar Board Premier, as redshirt freshman Bayly Poor was the lone representative named to the All-Tournament team at the Sports Imports D.C. Koehl Classic.

FIRST SERVE

Mr. 300: Chad Callihan recorded his 300th win against Idaho on Sept. 15. His 74 wins at Wyoming are third most in program history, and the 36 conference wins are also third best for a UW head coach.

Offering Assistance: As a junior, Courtney Chacon became just the ninth Cowgirl in school history to record at least 2,000 career assists. For her career, she is now seventh all-time with 2,701 assists. So far this season, Chacon is tenth in the MW with 343 assists and an average of 8.17 assists per set. Additionally, Chacon has led the Cowgirls in assists in all 13 matches this season.

Life's a Beach: Laura Beach sits at the top of the list in all-time hitting percentage as a Cowgirl. After hitting .337 last season and currently hitting a team-best .394 this year, Beach has a .364 hitting percentage for her career. She is also currently second in the MW with her .396 hitting percentage.

Double-Trouble: Courtney Chacon leads UW with three double-doubles this season, as she recorded her first during the UniWyo Invite. She also recorded her second and third double-doubles at the Idaho Volleyball Classic. Fellow senior Kayla Slofkiss recorded her first against Idaho.

Hard Block Cafe: Middle blocker Reed Copeland was named the 2015 MW Freshman of the Year after not only leading the MW but the NCAA in blocks and blocks per set. Copeland has continued leading UW defensively so far this season. She has 48 total blocks (1.14 bps) through the first 13 matches and has led the Cowgirls in blocks in six different matches.

Dig it Up: Junior Lily Austin has recorded at least 15 digs in six matches this season. She is ninth in the MW with an average of 3.67 per set and has a total of 154 through the first 13 matches. Her career-high came against Idaho, when she led the team with 21 digs. Austin is also second on the team with nine service aces.

Home Sweet Home: Success on their home court is nothing new for the current Cowgirls. Dating back to the 2013 season, Wyoming has won 84 percent of its matches in Laramie, sporting a record of 45-8.

First Weekend of MW at Home: Since Chad Callihan was hired as head coach, the Cowgirls have gone 5-1 during the first weekend of MW home matches. Last year, UW defeated Boise State and Utah State to begin conference play, while in 2014 the Cowgirls were victorious against San Diego State and UNLV. In Callihan's first season, Wyoming swept Boise State before falling to Utah State in the UniWyo Sports Complex.

Media members are also required to check with the Wyoming Media Relations Office prior to attending any Cowgirl practice session.
