#### THIS WEEK FOR THE COWGIRLS: UTAH STATE

<u>Mountain West Play:</u> The Cowgirl volleyball team will continue Mountain West play this weekend with its matchup with Utah State on Saturday. First serve is set for 6 p.m. MT on Kirby Court in the Wayne Estes Center in Logan, Utah.

<u>All-Time Series:</u> Wyoming leads the all-time series with the Aggies, 16-14. UW won both matches last season and have won three in a row against Utah State. The Cowgirls have a 6-5 record when playing the Aggies on their home court.

Mountain West Honors: Sophomore Reed Copeland was named the MW Defensive Player of the Week on Monday. After opening conference play with six kills and a season-high 11 blocks against San Jose State, Copeland recorded seven kills and three blocks against Fresno State. Despite leading the NCAA in blocks as a freshman, it was Copeland's first Player of the Week honors.

<u>Streaking:</u> The recent victories over San Jose State and Fresno State last weekend moved UW's current win streak to three. All three of those matches have been in straight sets and it is the second three-match win streak in straight sets this season. Additionally, Wyoming has won all six of its matches at home in the UniWyo Sports Complex by way of a three-set sweep.

<u>All-Tournament Team:</u> In the last nonconference tournament at the Idaho Volleyball Classic, senior Courtney Chacon and sophomore Emily Lewis were named to the all-tournament team. Sophomore Reed Copeland was the tournament MVP at the UniWyo Invite, as Chacon and Laura Beach were also honored for their stellar play. Junior Lily Austin was named to the All-Tournament team at the Purdue Mortar Board Premier, as redshirt freshman Bayly Poor was the lone representative named to the All-Tournament team at the Sports Imports D.C. Koehl Classic.

#### FIRST SERVE

Mr. 300: Chad Callihan recorded his 300th win against Idaho on Sept. 15. His 76 wins at Wyoming are third most in program history, and the 38 conference wins are also third best for a UW head coach.

Offering Assistance: As a junior, Courtney Chacon became just the ninth Cowgirl in school history to record at least 2,000 career assists. For her career, she is now sixth all-time with 2,752 assists. Additionally, Chacon has led the Cowgirls in assists in all 15 matches this season.

<u>Life's a Beach:</u> Laura Beach sits at the top of the list in all-time hitting percentage as a Cowgirl. After hitting .337 last season and currently hitting a team-best .405 this year, Beach has a .366 hitting percentage for her career. She is also currently second in the MW with her .405 hitting percentage.

<u>Double-Trouble:</u> Courtney Chacon leads UW with three double-doubles this season, as she recorded her first during the UniWyo Invite. She also recorded her second and third double-doubles at the Idaho Volleyball Classic. Fellow senior Kayla Slofkiss recorded her first against Idaho and second against Fresno State.

<u>Hard Block Cafe:</u> Middle blocker Reed Copeland was named the 2015 MW Freshman of the Year after not only leading the MW but the NCAA in blocks and blocks per set. Copeland has continued leading UW defensively so far this season. She has 62 total blocks (1.29 bps) through the first 15 matches and has led the Cowgirls in blocks in seven different matches.

<u>Dig it Up:</u> Junior Lily Austin has recorded at least 15 digs in six matches this season. She is ninth in the MW with an average of 3.40 per set and has a total of 163 through the first 15 matches. Her career-high came against Idaho, when she led the team with 21 digs. Austin is also second on the team with nine service aces.

<u>Home Sweet Home</u>: Success on their home court is nothing new for the current Cowgirls. Dating back to the 2013 season, Wyoming has won 85 percent of its matches in Laramie, sporting a record of 47-8.

<u>First Weekend of MW at Home:</u> Since Chad Callihan was hired as head coach, the Cowgirls have gone 7-1 during the first weekend of MW home matches. Last year, UW defeated Boise State and Utah State to begin conference play, while in 2014 the Cowgirls were victorious against San Diego State and UNLV. In Callihan's first season, Wyoming swept Boise State before falling to Utah State in the UniWyo Sports Complex. UW opened MW action with two sweeps over San Jose State and Fresno State this last weekend.
