# **Up Next:** For the sixth consecutive year, the University of Wyoming Cowgirl golf program will host the Cowgirl Desert Intercollegiate at the Classic Club in Palm Desert, Calif. The two-day tournament will take place Oct. 1-2.

Classic Club: The Classic Club is a nationally recognized 18-hole golf course. Not only has it been the host of UW's fall tournament, it also was the host site for the 2006, 2007, 2008 Bob Hope Classic. The Cowgirls will look to continue its fall season momentum on the par-72, 6,112 yard course in Palm Desert.

Hankins Top-Ten: After redshirting a year ago, Sarah Hankins has been the highlight of the Cowgirls fall season thus far. Hankins earned her first top-ten finish at the Nebraska Chip-N Club last week with a 221 (+5). Her three-round total is the lowest individual tournament score of 2016 for the Cowgirls. Additionally, the redshirt sophomore recorded the lowest round in two of the three days in Lincoln.

#### Gibson and Knadler lead UW at CSU Ram Fall Classic:

Junior Gabrielle Gibson and sophomore Kaylee Knadler were the top golfers for UW during the CWU Ram Fall Classic. They were the only golfers to finish within the top-30 and posted a three-round score of 227 (+11) to tie for 29th.

#### **Three Cowgirls Named WGCA All-American:**

Kathleen Kershisnik and Emily Woodard were joined by Klara Castillo on the WGCA All-American team. Kershisnik became the first four-time honoree for Wyoming. Woodard was honored for the third-consecutive year, as Castillo was honored for the first time. This marks the second-straight year that three different Cowgirls have been All-American's in the same year. Kershisnik, Woodard and Sarah Hankins achieved the feat last season, as Mikala Henzlik, Kaelee Aegerter and Laura Mengelkamp were named All-American scholars during the 2007 season.

#### COWGIRLS TIE FOR FOURTH AT NEBRASKA CHIP-N CLUB

The University of Wyoming women's golf team tied for fourth place at the Nebraska Chip-N Club after recording the second-lowest team round in program history during Tuesday's final 18 holes. UW carded a 292 (+4) en route to a three-round total of 906 (+42). Wyoming's tournament score also tied for eighth-best in Cowgirl history.

"I am so proud of this talented group," Cowgirl head coach Josey Stender said. "To be able to move up five places and have each player improve every round is a credit to their talent and effort. Sarah (Hankins) stayed positive and focused throughout the tournament. It shows she was able to take advantage of her redshirt year and work on every aspect of her game. This group is well deserving of all the success, and I know they enjoyed it."

Three Wyoming players finished among the top-25 individually. Redshirt sophomore Sarah Hankins shot a 73 (+1) in the final round to earn a share of eighth place. It was her first-career top-ten finish, as she posted a 221 (+5) to pace the Cowgirls. Junior Gabrielle Gibson tied for 16th at 225 (+7), and had an impressive final round with a 71 (-1) for UW. It was Gibson's eighth top-25 finish of her stellar career. Freshman Erin Sargent recorded her first-career top-25 finish with a three-day total of 229 (+13). Sargent, like Gibson, posted a 71 (-1) on Tuesday for 24th place in the 65-player field.

Senior Mackenzie Barrie closed out the tournament with a 77 (+5) at the Wilderness Ridge Golf Course to earn a share of 31st. Barrie finished with a 232 (+16), while sophomore Megan Knadler totaled a 237 (+21) after her 77 (+5) during the final round. Junior Klara Castillo posted UW's best round of the tournament on Tuesday with a 70 (-2), which tied her career-low. Playing as an individual, Castillo tied for 34th with a 233 (+17).

Of the 11 teams, Wyoming was only behind Kansas State in par 3 and par 5 scoring with 3.10 and 4.24, respectively. Additionally, UW was fourth in the tournament field with 11 birdies during the three-day tournament.

Kansas State was the tournament champion with a 878 (+14), while South Dakota State's Hallie Getz earned the individual crown with a three-round total of 213 (-1).

The Cowgirls will next hit the course this weekend as host of the Wyoming Cowgirl Desert Intercollegiate. The two-day tournament will take place at the Classic Club in Palm Desert, Calif., beginning on Saturday.
