

University of Wyoming Postgame Notes

Following a 42-34 win at Nevada on Oct. 22, 2016, at Mackay Stadium in Reno, Nev.

Team Notes

- Saturday night's match up marked the seventh all-time meeting between the two school.
- Wyoming moves to 4-3 all-time against Nevada
- The Cowboys move to 5-2 on the season and 3-0 in MW play for the first time in school history. The last time UW opened conference play 3-0 was in 1998 in the Western Athletic Conference.

Offensive Notes

- Hill rushed for a career-high 289 yards on 29 carries averaging 10 yards per carry. It was the second most rushing yards in a single-game in Wyoming history. He now owns four of the top-10 rushing games in school history.
 - Hill had a career-high three rushing touchdowns.
 - Hill's total was the highest in the MW this season.
 - Hill had seven rushes over 15 yards on the night.
- Hill rushed for 41 yards on the Pokes' first offensive play. He rushed for 97 yards in the first quarter.
- Hill moved to seventh all-time in career rushing touchdowns, as he now has 23 passing Wynel Seldon (22).
- Hill rushed for 289 yards. It was his second 200 yard game of the season and the seventh of his career. It was the fourth time he has done so on the road.
 - Hill now has 1,010 yards rushing this season. He also has 3,437 career rushing yards.
- Redshirt freshman Austin Conway threw a touchdown pass to Josh Allen. It was the first non-quarterback to throw a touchdown for UW since Chris McNeil (WR) did it against Toledo in 2012.
- Senior wide receiver Tanner Gentry had four grabs for 109 yards. He has 2,101 career receiving yards ranking eighth in school history.
- Redshirt sophomore quarterback Josh Allen threw for 135 yards on 8-of-12 passing. He also rushed for 52 yards with two touchdowns and one receiving touchdown.
- Senior running back Shaun Wick had 45 rushing yards on nine carries. He now has 2,347 career rushing yards.
- The Pokes rushed for a season-high 401 rushing yards. It was the most since rushing for 430 yards against Eastern Michigan last season. UW averaged 7.2 yards per carry.

Defensive Notes

- The Pokes now have 15 sacks on the season. It is the most under head coach Craig Bohl during his time at UW.
- Sophomore free safety Andrew Wingard recorded 11 tackles on the night. He has double-digit tackles in 12 career games.
- Redshirt freshman Logan Wilson added nine tackles tying a career high. He added a sack and an interception to seal the game for the Pokes.
 - Sophomore Antonio Hull had a career-high 10 tackles for the Pokes.

Special Teams' Notes

- •Senior Ethan Wood punted three times averaging 38.3 yards per kick.
- Freshman Cooper Rothe was 0-of-1 on field goals, but was 6-for-6 on extra points.
