THIS WEEK FOR THE COWGIRLS: COLORADO STATE & UTAH STATE

Mountain West Play: The Cowgirl volleyball team will welcome league-leading Colorado State as well as Utah State to Laramie to continue Mountain West play this week. First serve is set for 6:30 p.m. MT for both matches, as UW and the Rams will face off on Tuesday before a date with the Aggies on Thursday.

All-Time Series: Colorado State holds a 61-19 lead in the all-time series and have won ten in a row. The last time UW defeated CSU was on Oct. 8, 2011 in the UniWyo Sports Complex. The Cowgirls defeated the Aggies earlier this season by way of a three-set sweep. That win brought the all-times series to 17-14 in favor of Wyoming. UW has currently won four-consecutive against Utah State.

Mountain West Honors: Sophomore Reed Copeland was named the MW Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 26. After opening conference play with six kills and a season-high 11 blocks against San Jose State, Copeland recorded seven kills and three blocks against Fresno State. Despite leading the NCAA in blocks as a freshman, it was Copeland's first Player of the Week honors. Senior Courtney Chacon landed the Offensive Player of the Week honors on Monday Oct. 3. She recorded a season-high 40 assists (13.33 aps) against Utah State.

FIRST SERVE

Winning Ways: Chad Callihan recorded his 300th win against Idaho on Sept. 15. His 80 wins at Wyoming are second most in program history, and the 42 conference wins are also second best for a UW head coach. Former head coach Mike English holds the all-time record for conference wins with 46.

Miss 3,000: Against San Jose State, senior Courtney Chacon became just the sixth Cowgirl in program history to record 3,000 assists in a career. She has dished out 3,013 for sixth place all-time and has led the Cowgirls in assists in all 22 matches this season. Chacon needs 40 digs to join Chris Lambert (1983-86) and Jil Robins (1991-94) as the only Cowgirls with at least 3,000 assists and 900 digs.

Life's a Beach: Laura Beach sits at the top of the list in all-time hitting percentage as a Cowgirl. After hitting .337 last season and currently hitting a team-best .401 this year, Beach has a .369 hitting percentage for her career. She leads the MW with her .401 hitting percentage, and is 18th overall in the NCAA. Beach is also seventh all-time with 397 career blocks while wearing the Brown and Gold.

Double-Trouble: Three Cowgirls have recorded at least one double-double this season, as Courtney Chacon leads UW with five. Fellow senior Kayla Slofkiss has three, while sophomore Reed Copeland had her first against San Diego State.

Hard Block Cafe: Middle blocker Reed Copeland was named the 2015 MW Freshman of the Year after not only leading the MW but the entire NCAA in blocks and blocks per set. Copeland has continued leading UW defensively so far this season. She has 99 total blocks (1.32 bps) through the first 22 contests and has led the Cowgirls in blocks in ten different matches.

Dig it Up: Freshman Madi Fields has been nothing short of consistent since she joined the starting lineup. Her career-high in digs came against San Diego State, when she recorded 19. She is tenth in the MW with an average of 2.87. Additionally, junior Lily Austin has recorded at least 15 digs in six matches this season. Her career-high came against Idaho, when she led the team with 21 digs.

All-Tournament Team: In the last nonconference tournament at the Idaho Volleyball Classic, senior Courtney Chacon and sophomore Emily Lewis were named to the all-tournament team. Sophomore Reed Copeland was the tournament MVP at the UniWyo Invite, as Chacon and Laura Beach were also honored for their stellar play. Junior Lily Austin was named to the All-Tournament team at the Purdue Mortar Board Premier, as redshirt freshman Bayly Poor was the lone representative named to the All-Tournament team at the Sports Imports D.C. Koehl Classic.
