# COWBOYS LOOK TO BE ASSERTIVE IN EDWARDS'S FIRST SEASON AT THE HELM

**T**he Cowboys hit the court for their first practice of the Allen Edwards's era on Monday, Oct. 3. The Cowboys will have 31 days to prepare for their first game of the season, an exhibition game against Chadron State on Saturday, Nov. 3 in Torrington.

Edwards was introduced as the 21st head coach of the Cowboy basketball program by University of Wyoming Athletics Director Tom Burman on March 21, 2016. He had previously served as an assistant under former UW head coach Larry Shyatt the previous five seasons. With 12 appearances in postseason tournaments and 14 conference championships, Edwards has created success during his playing career at Kentucky and as an assistant the past 14 seasons.

"This opportunity to lead the Wyoming Cowboys is a blessing I'm truly thankful for," Edwards said. "I'd like to thank Larry Shyatt for bringing me to Laramie and allowing me to grow and develop as a professional with his help. My gratitude to Tom Burman, as well, for the faith that I can continue the tradition of success in the game of basketball and the game of life that Larry has established for this program."

## MCMANAMEN LEADS GROUP

## OF EXPERIENCED REUTURNERS

Edwards welcomes back four starters and nine total letter-winners from last season's team. Senior guard Jason McManamen emerged as one of the top three-point shooters in the MW and the

NCAA last season, as his 44 percent beyond the arc ranked second in the conference and 15th in the nation. McManamen averaged 14.4 points per game last season. He will be joined by juniors Alan Herndon, Jeremy Lieberman and Jonathan Barnes.

"I think this is a team that has experience," Edwards said. "We have nice mixture of older and younger guys, not just in age, but in court experience. It is exciting to see and is something we can build around."


McManamen downed 3.0 triples per game last season for second in the Mountain West and 27th in the nation. His efforts earned him All-MW Honorable Mention honors by the leagues coaches and media.

Herndon was second on the team in field goal percentage at 52 percent last season. He was third on the team in scoring as a sophomore pouring in 7.8 per game. Lieberman started 22 games last season shooting 35 percent from beyond the three point line. Barnes started 23 games for the Pokes in 2015-16.

The UW bench returns sophomore guard Justin James. He averaged 5.2 points per game as a freshman. Junior guard Alexander Aka Gorski added 5.6 points per game to go along with 2.0 rebounds. Junior forward Hayden Dalton will also add to the Pokes' bench. He finished his first season in the Brown and Gold averaging 3.8 points per game and 3.3 boards. Another promising big man is sophomore forward Jordan Naughton, as he added 3.0 points per game off the UW bench. Senior guard Morris Marshall will add to a deep bench after appearing in eight contests a season ago.

“We are going to be more assertive both offensively and defensively,” Edwards said. “This team is different than what we have had in the past. We are very skilled and have a great ability to shoot the basketball. I want our guys to be confident offensively and defensively be aggressive inside the half court.”

**FOUR NEWCOMERS**

Edwards added four newcomers to this season’s roster. Junior college transfer junior guard Louis Adams and freshman forward Austin Mueller will be eligible to play for UW this season. Transfers Nyaires Redding from Washington State and Brodricks Jones of UTEP will sit out this season to satisfy NCAA transfer rules.

Adams helped lead his team to their first NJCAA National Tournament since 2011 and helped win an NJCAA Region 5 Championship. He averaged 11.9 points per game to go along with 3.5 rebounds. He was strong from the field, shooting 53 percent to go along with 72 percent from the free throw line.

Mueller earned All-Continental League honors and was also recruited by Colorado, Northeastern, Denver and Northern Colorado.

Redding comes to the Cowboys after playing two seasons at Washington State. The 6-2, 168-pound guard averaged 2.7 points and 1.4 rebounds in 60 games with 22 starts.

Jones averaged 1.3 points and 1.4 rebounds in 16 games off the bench for UTEP last season. Jones was a four-star recruit and a national top-100 player out of high school according to Rivals.com.

**THE SCHEDULE**

Wyoming basketball fans will have the opportunity to see the Cowboys host a pair of NCAA Tournament teams, along with two popular regional rivals and the first two rounds of the Continental Tire Las Vegas Classic during the 2016 nonconference schedule.

On Saturday, Dec. 3, the Cowboys will host Northern Iowa in the Mountain West/Missouri Valley Challenge. The Cowboys will host 2016 Summit League Tournament Champion South Dakota State on Saturday, Nov. 19. South Dakota State earned an automatic bid to the 2016 NCAA Tournament following its Summit League title.

In addition to the road game at Montana and the road games in the Las Vegas Classic, Wyoming will travel to northern California for games in Stockton, Calif., versus Pacific on Tuesday, Nov. 22 and in Berkeley, Calif., on Friday, Nov. 25 vs. the Cal Bears. Cal is the other Cowboy nonconference opponent that participated in last year’s NCAA Tournament.

The conference slate features nine home contests with nine road tilts. Highlighting the conference home schedule will be the annual Border War with Colorado State on Feb. 15 and the return of longtime rival New Mexico on February 25.

The Pokes will play home and home games with every team in the Mountain West with the exception of Nevada and San Diego State, which they will play once each.

**THE PLAYERS ACCORDING TO EDWARDS**

The following is Coach Edward’s player-by-player analysis of the 2016-17 lineup:

**SENIORS**

**Morris Marshall • Guard**

“I think Morris is a guy that fits what we are trying to do moving forward. During our practice prior to the Bahamas he worked at a high level. His athleticism and ability to shoot the basketball are some great intangibles. I’m interested to see him bring it everyday and he will be a part of what we want to do this season.

**Jason McManamen • Guard**

“Jason has really put something in the books for this program. He is respected by everyone in that locker room. He has to do what he did last year and take another step forward. Most people see Jason as a shooter, but we are adding some more dimensions to his game to make him more diverse.

SEASON OUTLOOK

JUNIORS

**Louis Adams • Guard**

"He was a great addition to the team especially that late in the recruiting process. He showed us flashes of what he is capable of doing down in the Bahamas. If he can continue that he can really help us with what we are trying to do with this program.

**Alexander Aka Gorski • Guard**

"I thought Alex did a tremendous job in the Bahamas. He is one of the guys I have been impressed with since taking over. He brings an extra dimension to this team with his ability to shoot the basketball.

**Jonathan Barnes • Forward**

"He is a physical presence on the floor. He is the best teammate on this team because he pushes for everyone to give their best. I want him to play with aggression and be a physical presence on the defensive end of the floor.

**Hayden Dalton • Forward**

"Hayden came back with a tremendous focus and confidence from the off-season. You can see it within what he does. The way the staff wants us to use his position, he fits it well.

**Alan Herndon • Forward**

"I have made it no secret to him and the team that for us to reach our potential as a team he needs to take a big step for this program. He can effect the game in so many ways with his size and skill level.

**Jeremy Lieberman • Guard**

"He is our hardest worker. Jeremy is one of the guys that you put in that gray area as a veteran. His role has to grow up a little as well as being a lead guard for us.

**Nyaires Redding • Guard**

"Nyaires is a great addition and fits what we are trying to do moving forward. He has great leadership qualities being the son of a coach. His ability to pressure the ball defensively will help us.

SOPHOMORES

**Justin James • Guard/Forward**

"Justin has tremendous potential and we need him to have a great year for us to have a good year. He is great athlete that can play multiple positions for us.

**Jordan Naughton • Forward**

"Potential wise I think he has a chance to be a great player in this league. His presence around the rim is a great asset. He is long and athletic with great touch around the rim. He has a good basketball IQ. We have been working on his ability to get up and down the floor. If he can do that, he can have a breakout year.

**Brodricks Jones • Forward**

"He fits what we are trying to do from a style of play. This year of sitting out will help develop other parts of his game.

REDSHIRT FRESHMEN

**Sam Averback • Forward**

"Sam brings a unique skill set to our program. His basketball IQ is off the charts. He pushes our guys to be better. He is trying to get himself into position to play.

**Cody Kelley • Forward**

"I think Cody's personality fits me well. His personality is great and he is very coachable. He played a lot in the Bahamas by design. He will be in the mix to play some minutes for us this season.

**Andrew Moemeka • Forward**

"I thought Andrew did a good job during the 10 days before the trip to the Bahamas. He brings a different dynamic from our other bigs because he is such a wiry player. With his athleticism he has the ability to guard anyone on the floor. He is in the process of getting better everyday.

### McManamen and Cowboys Head to Torrington

Fans in Torrington, Wyo. will be in for a special night when the Cowboys faceoff with Chadron State in an exhibition contest in the Petsch Activities Center on the campus of Eastern Wyoming College on Thursday evening. It will mark the return of senior guard Jason McManamen to his hometown. Tip off for the Pokes' only exhibition contest of the season is slated for 7 p.m.

Fans can watch the action with live video and stats on GoWyo.com. The game will be broadcast live on radio over the 25 affiliate stations of the Cowboy Sports Network.

#### A Look at the Matchup

First-year head coach Allen Edwards welcomes back four starters and nine total letterwinners from last season's team. The Cowboys return 63 percent of their starting lineup from last season. The Pokes also return 77 percent of their rebounding. Wyoming was one of the best teams in the Mountain West beyond the arc last season. The Pokes made a season-low five threes against Utah State on March 9, though. Wyoming still averaged 9.9 makes per game last season for first in the MW and 11th in the nation.

Chadron State also has a first-year head coach in Houston Reed. He spent the last 10 seasons at Otero Community College in Colorado sporting an impressive 117-47 record. The Eagles have eight newcomers players who are eligible this season. Reed inherited seven players who were on CSC's roster last year, when the Eagles recorded a 7-19 overall and a 5-17 in the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference an NCAA Division II affiliate.

#### Each Team's Leaders

McManamen emerged as one of the top three-point shooters in the MW and the NCAA last season, as his 44 percent beyond the arc ranked second in the conference and 15th in the nation. McManamen averaged 14.4 points per game a year ago. He will be joined by juniors Alan Herndon, Jeremy Lieberman and Jonathan Barnes.

Junior forward Matt Reader is the leading returner in rebounds averaging 4.0 per game. He will not be in uniform on Thursday and will join the team after the football team.

#### About the Series

Wyoming leads the all-time series by a mark of 3-0. It is the first meeting between the schools since 2007 when the Pokes defeated the Eagles 76-69 on New Year's Eve in the Arena-Auditorium. The series dates back to March 10, 1920 when the Pokes defeated Chadron State 41-14.

#### Up Next

The Pokes open the regular season by hosting Western State on Nov. 11 at 8:30 p.m. p.m. in the Arena-Auditorium.

## Notes

**Cowboys Picked 10th in MW Preseason Poll:** The University of Wyoming men's basketball team was picked to finish 10th in the Mountain West, as the conference announced its 2016-17 preseason media poll in mid-October. San Diego State was tabbed the preseason favorite to win the 2016-17 regular-season title by capturing 23 of 27 first-place votes for 293 points. Nevada received 253 points to finish second, followed by New Mexico with 249 points for third place. Fresno State received 200 points to finish fourth, followed by Boise State (164 points) and Utah State (153). Colorado State (146 points) was seventh, UNLV (120 points) rounded out the poll in eighth. Air Force garnered 90 points for ninth followed by the Cowboys and San Jose State.

**Experienced Group:** The Cowboys return four starters and nine letterwinners from last season's team. The Pokes only trail Air Force, who returns all five of their starters from last season in the MW this season. The nine letterwinners returning is also second in the league behind Air Force's 15 returning letterwinners.

**Behind the Arc:** Wyoming made a school record 307 three pointers last season. McManamen hit 92 shots from behind the arc last season, which ranks third in single-season three pointers at Wyoming. Josh Adams made the second most three pointers in school history last season with 96 meaning the Pokes return 213 three pointers, which would still rank fourth in single-season school history.

**Don't Leave Him Open:** Wyoming's Jason McManamen shot a team-best 44 percent from beyond the arc last season for second in the MW and 15th in the NCAA and his 3.0 triples per game were second and 27th, respectively. He is just outside the top-10 in career three pointers with 124. With three more triples he will tie Brett McFall (127) for 10th in career three pointers at Wyoming.

**Cowboys Play Exhibition Tour in Bahamas:** The Cowboys played three exhibition contests in the Bahamas in early August. The Pokes were allowed 10 days of practice prior to the trip. The Pokes went to Calgary, Alberta, in 2012 in their last exhibition tour. The Cowboys went 3-0 during the trip playing local teams in the Nassau, Bahamas area.

**Experienced Big:** Junior Alan Herndon tied a career-high with 16 points in the season finale against Utah State last season during the MW Tournament. He is the Cowboys' top rebounder returning this season as he averaged 4.8 board per game a season ago. He scored in double-figures 11 times a season ago and 12 times in his career.

### Notes

**TV Schedule Announced:** The Wyoming Cowboys announced game times and television coverage for the upcoming 2016-17 season on Thursday. The announcement came in connection with the Mountain West Conference and its network television partners announcing the 2016-17 conference television package.

The Cowboys will be featured on television 13 times during the regular season, starting with the Cowboys hosting Northern Iowa in the Mountain West/Missouri Valley Conference Challenge on Saturday, Dec. 3 on Campus Insiders.

Wyoming is scheduled to appear on CBS Sports Network telecasts two times during the regular season. ROOT SPORTS is scheduled to televise five Cowboy games including both Border War contests with Colorado State.

Campus Insiders will carry one non-conference contest that features Campus Insiders will also carry the Pokes' home contest against UNLV on Wednesday, Jan. 25. UW will have two games featured on FS1 during the Continental Tire Las Vegas Classic on Dec. 22 and 23.

Additionally, the Cowboys will have two contests showcased on ESPN3. The Pokes home games against Nevada on Saturday, Jan. 14 and New Mexico on Saturday, Feb. 25 will be featured.

**JMac Attack:** Guard Jason McManamen averaged 4.3 triples made over the last 10 contests of last season, including a career-high eight versus Fresno State on Feb. 17. He reached double figures the last 10 games of the season, including four 20-point efforts. His 14.4 points per game last season ranked 11th in the MW.

**The Three Ball:** Wyoming was one of the best teams in the Mountain West beyond the arc last season. Wyoming averaged 9.9 makes per game this season for first in the MW and 11th in the nation. Wyoming's 37 percent from deep this season ranked first in the conference and 61st nationally. The Cowboys attempted 26.7 per game this season after attempting more than 20 in just one other season under Shyatt.

**Edwards Adds UTEP Transfer:** University of Wyoming head basketball coach Allen Edwards announced Monday that Brodricks "Buddha" Jones will transfer to UW from the University of Texas El Paso. The 6-10, 220-pound forward will sit out the 2016-17 season to fulfill NCAA transfer rules, and will have three years of eligibility remaining.

A native of Los Angeles, Calif., Jones was a four-star recruit and a national top-100 player out of high school according to Rivals.com. He was also a highly-ranked forward by ESPN and Scout.com with both services giving him a three-star rating.

**Cowboys Add Walk-On Transfer:** University of Wyoming head basketball coach Allen Edwards announced June 6 that Nyaires (Ny-air-ees) 'Ny' Redding will transfer to UW from Washington State University. He will sit out the 2016-17 season to fulfill NCAA transfer rules, and will have two years of eligibility remaining. Redding is the step-son of Wyoming assistant coach Jermaine Kimbrough and will be a walk-on for the Cowboy basketball program.

**Taking Care of the Ball:** The had 10 or less in eight of their last 14 games. That included a season-low two versus Colorado State on Jan. 30. Wyoming averaged just 11.2 per game last season for second in the MW and 43rd in the NCAA. The Pokes had 10 or less turnovers in 13 total games.

**Cardiac Cowboys:** Wyoming played 17 games decided by single digits last season, as the Cowboys were competitive in almost every game. In 17 of 18 conference games Wyoming was within five points of the lead in the final 10 minutes, while in 13 of their 17 losses UW was within two possessions of the lead in the last 10 minutes.

**Defending Without Fouling:** The Pokes averaged 18.7 fouls per game last season for third in the MW and 123rd in the NCAA. A Cowboy fouled out just 11 times. On the flipside, UW forced its foes into more than 20 fouls in 22 of 31 games.

**Record-Setting Threes:** The Cowboys knocked home a school and Arena-Auditorium record 20 threes against Utah State on Feb. 6 last season thanks to a season-high 53 percent (20-of-38) beyond the arc. The 20 triples also tied a Mountain West record and tied for the most in an NCAA game this season. The Pokes also attempted 38 triples against Utah State to set a school record, while ranking second in AA history. UW's 307 made triples in 2015-16 were first in UW single-season history, while their 829 attempts were also first. Individually, Josh Adams' 96 were second in UW single season and Jason McManamen's 92 were third.

**Making the Freebies:** The Cowboys averaged 72 percent at the charity stripe last season for fourth in the MW and 114th in the NCAA. Senior guard Josh Adams' team-high 83 percent was fourth in the MW, as he made and attempted the sixth-most free throws in the NCAA (202 makes/246 attempts).

# 2016-17 WYOMING GAME NOTES

## Head Coach Allen Edwards



Allen Edwards was introduced as the 21st head coach of the Cowboy basketball program by University of Wyoming Athletics Director Tom Burman on March 21, 2016. He had previously served as an assistant under former UW head coach Larry Shyatt the previous five seasons. With 12 appearances in postseason tournaments and 14 conference championships, Edwards has created success during his playing career at Kentucky and as an assistant the past 14 seasons.

"An institution is fortunate when it has the opportunity to hire its next head coach from within a successful program," Burman said at the time of Edwards' hiring. "Larry Shyatt's Cowboy basketball

legacy has allowed us to do that. We are thrilled to place its future in the hands of Allen Edwards. His basketball pedigree is undeniable, including two national championships with one of the game's most storied programs, Kentucky. He has coached with, and played under some of the game's finest coaches. During his five years here, his impact on our program has been significant, while earning the respect of our players. We believe Wyoming basketball has an extremely bright future."

"This opportunity to lead the Wyoming Cowboys is a blessing I'm truly thankful for," Edwards said. "I'd like to thank Larry Shyatt for bringing me to Laramie and allowing me to grow and develop as a professional with his help. My gratitude to Tom Burman, as well, for the faith that I can continue the tradition of success in the game of basketball and the game of life that Larry has established for this program."

Since joining the program in 2011, Edwards has helped the Pokes compile an overall record of 98-69. He added to his extensive postseason experience with the Cowboys qualifying for the CBI from 2012-14 and the NCAA Championships in 2015. That 2014-15 season included winning the Mountain West tournament title to secure the Pokes' first appearance in the NCAA tournament since 2002. During his time in Laramie, the Cowboys have claimed six wins over top-25 opponents, including one against a top-five foe, and six players have earned 15 all-conference honors, including a MW Player of the Year and two MW Defensive Players of the Year. He helped coach Larry Nance Jr., who was picked 27th overall in the first round of last year's NBA draft by the Los Angeles Lakers. Edwards also took the reins for one game on Jan. 22, 2014, to lead Wyoming to a come-from-behind 66-59 win at Air Force when Shyatt was ill.

"I want to congratulate coach Shyatt on the outstanding job he did at Wyoming," Nance said. "He took a 10-win program to nearly four-straight seasons with 20 wins. It's awesome to see him get some time to relax for a little bit. He's earned that. In the same breath, he couldn't be handing off the program to a more capable person. Coach Edwards is one of the smartest basketball minds I know, even at the NBA level. How he handles his players and staff, he commands respect and he deserves it. Allen is the right man for the job and he will continue the success there at Wyoming."

Edwards came to Wyoming from Western Kentucky, where he spent the 2010-11 season under Ken McDonald as an assistant coach. The Hilltoppers finished 16-16 overall, including 8-8 in the Sun Belt Conference, with a pair of first team all-conference players. Prior to WKU, Edwards spent 2009-10 as an assistant at Towson University under head coach Pat Kennedy.

Those two positions for Edwards came after a very productive three-year stint at Virginia Commonwealth University with head coach Anthony Grant from 2006-09. He helped guide the Rams to a 76-25 overall record during that time, including 45-9 in the Colonial Athletic Association, as the Rams won three conference regular-season titles and two tournament titles. VCU played in the NCAA tournament twice, including a first-round upset of Duke in 2007, and the NIT once. During that 2006-07 season, the Rams led the nation in three-point field goal percentage defense and were 10th in field goal percentage defense. Edwards helped cultivate Eric Maynor, the 20th overall pick in the 2009 NBA draft, and Larry Sanders, the 15th overall selection in the 2010 NBA draft.

Edwards' first full-time assistant position was at Morehead State from 2003-06 under head coach Kyle Macy. He previously spent the 2002-03 as a special assistant to head coach Tubby Smith at Kentucky, as he returned to complete his degree in sociology. During that season, the Wildcats went 16-0 in the SEC to win the conference regular season and

tournament and advance to the NCAA's Elite Eight.

Edwards enjoyed a tremendous playing career at Kentucky from 1995-98 that included three seasons under Rick Pitino and one under Smith. The Wildcats advanced to three-straight Final Fours during Edwards' sophomore, junior and senior seasons, including winning national titles in 1996 and 1998. During his freshman campaign, Kentucky made the Elite Eight. With Edwards, the Wildcats compiled a 132-16 overall record and won three SEC regular-season crowns and three tournament titles. He averaged 9.2 points, 3.3 assists and 3.3 rebounds as a senior. Following his collegiate career, Edwards played professionally in the CBA and the IBL.

A native of Miami, Edwards played his prep career at Miami Senior High School where he and his two brothers collected five prep state titles. Allen is married to the former LaTanya Webb, a two-time All-SEC volleyball player at Kentucky. They have two daughters, Mai'a (15) and Landree (4), and a son, Jaxson (8). Edwards will be 40 years old when the 2016-17 season starts.

## 2016-17 WYOMING GAME NOTES

### Assistant Coach Jeremy Shyatt



Jeremy Shyatt begins his sixth season as an assistant coach for Wyoming during 2016-17. The oldest son of former head coach Larry Shyatt, Jeremy helped guide the Cowboys to a 25-10 overall record during the 2014-15 campaign for a Mountain West tournament title and Wyoming's first berth in the NCAA tournament since 2001-02. Shyatt was at North Florida for two seasons prior to coming to UW.

At North Florida, Shyatt assisted head coach Matthew Driscoll, who was an assistant at Wyoming during the 1997-98 season under Larry. During his time

with the Ospreys, Shyatt helped build a resurgence of the basketball program. North Florida won 28 games in the two years, after having won just 22 total games in the four years prior to that.

In 2010-11, UNF finished 15-19 overall and 10-10 in the Atlantic Sun Conference. The 15 wins matched the most in school history and the 10 conference wins also set a school record. The Ospreys fell one game short of the NCAA Tournament, losing to Belmont in the Atlantic Sun Championship game. It marked the first time that North Florida had played in a conference championship game. In addition, North

Florida won the Mayan Division of the 2010 Cancun Challenge. Prior to their trip to Cancun, the Ospreys traveled to Wyoming and beat the Cowboys in the Arena-Auditorium.

At UNF, Shyatt was involved in many facets of the program including on-court coaching, recruiting, opponent scouting, team academic progress, housing, camps, skill development and was the team's video coordinator. He helped design the team's basketball locker room, and oversaw their Nike account and student-managers.

Prior to taking the job at UNF, Shyatt spent two seasons at Virginia Commonwealth University as the team's Director of Basketball Operations. During his stint at VCU, the Rams won two regular-season conference championships, advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2009 and earned an NIT berth in 2008. He helped coach Eric Maynor, the 20th overall selection in the 2009 NBA draft and Larry Sanders, the 15th overall selection in the 2010 NBA draft.

Shyatt held the same Director of Basketball Operations title at East Carolina University from 2005-07.

From 2003-05, Shyatt was a volunteer assistant coach at the University of South Carolina. There, he earned a master's degree in integrated communication and advertising.

From 2002-05, Shyatt served as director of the Boys and Girls Summer Day Camps with the NBA's Cleveland Cavaliers.

### Assistant Coach Tony Pujol



University of Wyoming men's basketball head coach Allen Edwards completed his 2016-17 staff April 19 with the hiring of Tony Pujol as an assistant coach. Pujol previously spent time at Alabama and VCU.

Pujol last coached collegiately at Alabama for five seasons from 2010-2014 under head coach Anthony Grant. Pujol helped the Crimson Tide compile a 99-71 record during his time on the staff, including three-straight 20-win seasons for the first time since 1990-92. Alabama earned two NIT bids and one NCAA bid from 2011-13 and finished runner-up in the NIT in 2011.

That 2010-11 Crimson Tide team featured one of the toughest defenses in the nation, as Alabama surrendered only 59.4 points per game, the eighth-lowest average in the nation. Alabama's tenacious defense helped it go 19-0 at home during that season. On the recruiting trail, he helped the Tide land a 2011 recruiting class that Rivals.com ranked as the fifth best in the nation with four prospects ranked in the top 100 nationally. After the 2013-14 season, Pujol

stepped away from collegiate coaching to dedicate more time to his family and has coached the last year and a half in the AAU ranks in New Jersey.

Previously, Pujol served under Grant at VCU from 2006-09 with Edwards and Jeremy Shyatt. The staff guided the Rams to a 76-25 record in those three seasons, including 45-9 in the Colonial Athletic Association. VCU won three conference regular-season titles and two tournament titles in that span to play in the NCAA tournament twice and NIT once. Two Rams from that team, Eric Maynor and Larry Sanders, would go on to be selected in the NBA draft. Pujol joined Grant's staff after two seasons at Appalachian State from 2004-06, where he helped the Mountaineers win the Southern Conference North Division in 2005. The team also earned the NCAA's Public Recognition Award based on the program's APR. His recruits would help ASU win a school-record 25 games the season after he left.

Prior to his collegiate career, Pujol was a high school coach in south Florida for 13 seasons, including nine at Northwest Christian Academy in Miami, where he posted a 250-46 record with state titles in 1999, 2003 and 2004. He graduated from Sterling College (Kansas) in 1989 with a degree in business administration and was a standout in both basketball and baseball, earning all-conference honors on the diamond in his final three seasons.

### Assistant Coach Jermaine Kimbrough



University of Wyoming men's basketball head coach Allen Edwards announced April 14 the hiring of Jermaine Kimbrough as an assistant coach. Kimbrough came to Laramie from Nevada and Cleveland State.

Kimbrough spent the 2015-16 season under head coach Eric Musselman at Nevada. The first-year staff guided the Wolf Pack to a 24-14 overall record, including a 10-8 mark in the conference for fourth in the Mountain West regular-season standings. More importantly, Nevada accepted a bid to the CBI and won the tournament for the MW's first postseason title in men's basketball. With

Kimbrough's help, two Wolf Pack players earned four All-MW honors, including freshman forward Cameron Oliver being named to the All-MW Third Team, All-Defensive Team and All-Tournament Team.

Kimbrough came to Nevada after nine seasons from 2006-14 as an assistant under head coach Gary Waters at Cleveland State. During that time he helped the Vikings to a pair of Horizon League Championships, one NCAA tournament, three NIT trips and a CollegenInsider.com Tournament appearance. Cleveland State had five 20-wins campaigns

in Kimbrough's nine seasons with a 157-112 overall record. He also coached Norris Cole at CSU, who was selected in the 2011 NBA draft.

Kimbrough's coaching career started at the NJCAA's Howard College where he spent two seasons as an assistant from 2001-03. He moved on to serve as Director of Operations at Cleveland State in 2003-04 and Massachusetts in 2004-05. During that season the Minutemen knocked off No. 2 Connecticut, No. 20 George Washington and No. 23 Florida State. Kimbrough would move on to serve as an assistant coach for one season at IPFW before returning to Cleveland State.

During his playing career, Kimbrough spent two seasons at St. Catherine College, before transferring to Virginia Tech for two seasons from 1998-2000. He would go on to graduate from Virginia Tech with his bachelor's degree in psychology in 2001.

Kimbrough played his prep career at Shaker Heights High School in Cleveland and earned all-league honors four times and all-city accolades three times. He was named second-team all-state as a senior after averaging 26 points per game.

Jermaine and his wife, Tameka, have five children.


