

University of Wyoming Postgame Notes

Following a 69-66 road loss to UNLV on Nov. 12, 2016, at Sam Boyd Stadium in Las Vegas, Nev.

Team Notes

- Today's game marked the 23rd meeting between the two schools in a series that dates back to 1978.
- Wyoming leads the series 12-11 after today's loss.
- UNLV snapped a three-game losing streak to the Pokes for their first win over UW since 2010.
- For the first time since 2006 the Pokes have played overtime in two games during the season and for the first time in school history the Pokes played two 3OT games in the same season.
- The Pokes have played 14 overtime games in school history after today. Wyoming is now 7-7 all-time in overtime contests and 2-1 in triple overtime.
 - The Cowboys saw their five game winning streak snapped with the loss.
 - The Pokes have scored over 50 points in back-to-back games for the first time since 1988.
 - Today's 66 points marked the most by the Cowboys since 66 points against Hawai'i in 1996.
 - The 135 combined points in the game was the second most in NCAA History.

Offensive Notes

- Junior running back Brian Hill rushed for 119 yards with three touchdowns. His seventh 100-yard game of the season and 18th of his career.
- Hill has 16 touchdowns this season, which is the most since Ryan Yarbrough had 16 in 1993. He now has 29 in his career ranking sixth in Wyoming history. His 29 rushing touchdowns rank third in career rushing touchdowns at UW.
 - Hill has 3, 844 career rushing yards in his career ranking third all-time in MW history.
- Hill has 1,411 yards this season ranking the third most in single-season school history. He now owns two of the top-three rushing marks.
- Wide receiver senior Tanner Gentry grabbed five catches for a career-high 184 yards with a career-high three touchdowns.
- Gentry has 17 touchdown receptions in his career ranking sixth at UW, as he passed former teammate Dominic Rufran.
- Tight end Jacob Hollister had four catches for 91 yards with one touchdown. He now has a new single season best 491 yards receiving. He also has 11 touchdowns in his career with the Pokes.

Defensive Notes

- Senior linebacker Lucas Wacha recorded 16 tackles, which is a career-high. He now has 317 career tackles ranking 10th in UW history.
- Redshirt freshman linebackér Logan Wilson recorded a career-high 13 tackles. He also added a touchdown on a fumble recovery.
 - Sophomore safety Marcus Epps recorded 12 tackles for his sixth career game with double-digit tackles.
 - The Rebels rushed for 401 yards for the most against the Pokes this season.
 - Sophomore safety Andrew Wingard added 11 tackles.
 - Senior defensive tackle Chase Appleby added a career-high nine tackles.

Special Teams Notes

- Senior punter Ethan Wood had six punts averaging 46.7 yards per punt.
- Freshman kicker Cooper Rothe was 1-of-1 on field goals. He is 10-of-16 on the season. He made a career-high nine extra points and is 49-of-49 this season on extra points.
- Redshirt freshman returned a punt for a touchdown in the fourth quarter. The 60 yard return was the first by a Cowboy since Chris McNeil returned one 75 yards for a touchdown against UNLV on Oct. 15, 2011.

 • Senior kick returner D.J. May returned a kickoff 59 yards in the fourth quarter. It was a career-high
- return for May.
