

University of Wyoming Postgame Notes

Following a 35-56 road loss vs. New Mexico on Nov. 26, 2016, at Branch Field at University Stadium in Albuquerque, N.M.

Team Notes

- Today's game marked the 69th meeting between the schools in a series that dates back to 1930.
 - Wyoming leads the all-time series against the Lobos 36-33.
 - The Pokes are 18-18 all-time in Albuquerque.
 - Wyoming, New Mexico and Boise State tied for the MW Mountain Division title.
- Wyoming earned a spot in the MW Championship game next week last night holding the tie breaker of record inside the division.

Offensive Notes

- Junior running back Brian Hill went over 4,000 career yards on a 20-yard rush in the first quarter. He is the first Cowboy to that mark and only the third rusher in MW history to achieve that mark. He has 4,101 rushing yards in his career.
- Hill added another 20 yard rush in the third quarter that broke his single-season rushing mark of 1,631 set last season. He now has 1,674 yards rushing this season.
 - Hill went over 100 yards for the ninth time this season and 20th of his career.
- Senior running back Shaun Wick rushed for a season-high 63 yards. He rushed for 41 yards in a single drive to setup the Pokes first score of the night.
- Senior wide receiver Tanner Gentry grabbed five catches for 112 yards. He now has 1,132 yards receiving this season ranking sixth in single-season school history.
 - Gentry also has 2,621 in his career with the Cowboys ranking sixth in career receiving yards.
- Sophomore Josh Harshman grabbed on pass for 22 yards. It was his longest catch of the season.
 - Sophomore James Price grabbed two passes. It was the most receptions for him this season.

Defensive Notes

- The Pokes allowed a school record 568 rushing yards. It was the most since allowing 548 to Wisconsin on Oct. 6, 1973.
 - The Cowboys allowed a school record 690 yards of total offense.
- Senior linebacker Lucas Wacha has 334 career tackles, as he tied Tyler Gottschalk (2000-03) for eighth in career tackles with 334 with nine tackles on the night.
 - Sophomore Andrew Wingard added nine tackles for UW. He has 119 on the season.

Special Teams Notes

- Senior punter Ethan Wood punted five times, averaging 42.6 yards per punt. He has now pinned opponents inside their 20-yard line over 30 times this season with just two touchbacks.
 - Freshman kicker Cooper Rothe added seven extra points and is now 60-for-60 on the season.
