University of Wyoming Postgame Notes

Following a 67-60 home win vs. Colorado Christian
on Dec. 5, 2016, at the Arena-Auditorium in Laramie, Wyo.

Team Notes

- Monday's meeting was the first meeting between the two-schools.
- The Cowboys moved to 2-0 on the season against members of the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference. The Pokes defeated Western State in the season opener.
- The Pokes hit only three triples in the first half. UW responded with five in the second frame
- The Cowboys move to 5-0 at home this season
- The Pokes shot 37 percent from the field, the lowest shooting percentage of the season at home for UW
- The Cowboys held the Cougars to 29 percent from the field, it was the lowest by an opponent this season. The Cougars came into the game shooting 51 percent from the field on the season
- The Pokes recorded seven blocks on the night, the second highest mark this season.
- The Cowboys grabbed 51 rebounds on the night. It was the most rebounds since UW grabbed 56 boards against Houston Baptist on Dec. 29, 2008.
- The Cowboys shot 31 three pointers. The Pokes have shot 30 or more threes three times this season.
- All 11 Cowboys grabbed at least one rebound on the night.

Individual Notes

- Junior forward Alan Herndon recorded a team-high 15 points. He has scored in double-figures in career-high five games.
- Herndon hit two three-pointers. He has hit at least two triples in the last three games.
- Senior guard Jason McManamen scored 10 points for the Pokes. He has scored in double-figures in six games this season and 34 times in his career.
- McManamen tied a career-high with four assists.
- Junior forward Alexander Aka Gorski added eight points on his 22nd birthday.
- Junior guard Jeremy Lieberman scored seven points on shy of his season high.
- Junior forward Hayden Dalton added a team-best eight rebounds.
