

## **University of Wyoming Postgame Notes**

Following an 85-83 win over Montana on Dec. 10, 2016, at the Arena-Auditorium in Laramie, Wyo.

## **Team Notes**

- Saturday's game marked the 35th game between the two teams. The two teams have met twice in the same season 13 times after today's game.
  - The Cowboys move to 23-12 all-time against the Griz.
- Saturday's matchup marked the first meeting between the two teams in Laramie since 2006. The Cowboys are 13-3 in Laramie against the Griz.
- The Cowboys and Griz combined for 50 fouls in the first meeting in Missoula. The teams again combined for 50 fouls on Saturday.
  - The Cowboys were 25-of-32 for 78 percent from the free throw line.
  - The Griz were 26-of-31 for 84 percent from the free throw line.
- The Pokes bench scored 40 points. It was the third time this season UW's bench has scored 40 or more points.
- Five Cowboys reached double-figure scoring for the first time since Nov. 16, 2014, against Northern Colorado.
- Saturday's game featured 20 lead changes, the most this season since the previous matchup in Missoula which saw 12 lead changes.
- Wyoming held the Griz to just nine assists, the fewest allowed since Pacific recorded the same amount.
- The Cowboys committed only nine turnovers on the afternoon, matching their second-lowest total this season.

## **Individual Notes**

- •Senior guard Jason McManamen recorded 20 points for his seventh game in double figures this season. He has now scored in double figures in 35 games in his career and cracked the 20-point mark 10 times in his career.
- McManamen was 7-of-10 from the free throw line. In two games against the Griz he is 18-of-24.
- Sophomore guard Justin James scored 16 points for his sixth game in double-figures this season.
- Redshirt freshman Cody Kelley recorded eight points, matching his career best. Kelley was 3-of-3 from the field, including 2-of-2 from beyond the arc.
- Junior forward Hayden Dalton scored 11 points for his fifth game in double figures on the year. Dalton was a perfect 6-of-6 from the charity stripe.
- Junior forward Alan Herndon recorded 11 points for his sixth-straight game in double figures, the longest streak for any Cowboy this season.
- Junior guard Louis Adams tallied 10 points, including the game-winning three-pointer with less than a second left on the clock.
  - Adams was 5-of-5 from the free throw line.
