University of Wyoming Postgame Notes

Following an 97-78 win over Cornell
on Dec. 17, 2016, at the Arena-Auditorium in Laramie, Wyo.

Team Notes

- Saturday's game was the first meeting between the two schools.
- Saturday's contest marked the first meeting from a team from the Ivy League since the Pokes played Princeton in 2005-06.
- The Cowboys are now 4-1 against members of the Ivy League.
- The Pokes are now 7-0 at home this season.
- The Cowboys have now won five-straight games.
- Wyoming scored 56 points in the opening half, the most in an opening stanza since scoring 56 against Arkansas State on Nov. 16, 2013.
- The Pokes shot 54 percent from the field in the first half for their highest field goal percentage in the opening frame this season. It was also the third-highest percentage in a half this season as UW shot 68 percent in the second half against UNI and 58 percent in the second half against Montana last week.
- The Cowboys dished out 21 assists on the afternoon, their second-highest total this season.
- UW tallied 40 points in the paint, the most this season.
- Wyoming's seven blocks were its second-most on the year.
- The Cowboys netted 12 three-pointers, UW has hit 10 or more triples in five games this season.

Individual Notes

- Senior guard Jason McManamen scored 15 points on 5-of-7 shooting, including 3-of-5 from beyond the arc. All his scoring plays came with three points. He had two and ones.
- Junior forward Hayden Dalton recorded 27 points for his sixth game in double figures this season. It marked his first 20-point game of his career.
- Dalton scored 21 points in the first half, the first time a Cowboy player scored 20 first-half points since Josh Adams scored 20 in the opening frame against Boise State in the MW Tournament semifinal.
- Dalton also added 11 rebounds for his second double-double of the season. He recorded his first against Montana on Nov. 14, 2016.
- Dalton shot a perfect 8-of-8 from the free throw line. Dalton has now converted his last 22 free throw attempts.
- Redshirt freshman guard Sam Averbuck added a career-high two points and three assists in a career-best 21 minutes.
- Junior forward Alan Herndon added 12 points for his eighth game in double-figures this season and the seventh straight double figure game.
- Herndon also swatted a career-best four blocks.
- Junior guard Louis Adams recorded a career-high 24 points. He hit a career-high three triples. It was his first 20-point game of his career.
- Junior guard Jeremy Lieberman added a career-high seven assists
