## University of Wyoming Postgame Notes

Following an 72-66 win over Troy  
on Dec. 19, 2016, at the Arena-Auditorium in Laramie, Wyo.

### Team Notes

- Monday's game was the second meeting between the two schools and the first since 1991.
- The Cowboys move to 2-0 all-time against the Trojans.
- UW is 2-0 in Laramie against Troy.
- Monday's game saw a delay of over two hours due to a power outage in the city of Laramie. It wasn't the first delay in Cowboy basketball history. The Pokes had a game called and played the next day due to a power outage against UMass on Dec. 7, 1996.
  - The Pokes trailed by 10 points in the first half. It was the largest deficit overcame for the Pokes this season.
  - The Cowboys move to 8-0 at home and have won six straight.
  - The UW bench combined for 40 points, the fourth time this season producing 40 or more points.
  - Wyoming's 36 points in the paint were its third-straight game scoring at least 30 points in the paint.
  - The Cowboys recorded a season-high 15 offensive rebounds.

### Individual Notes

- Junior forward Hayden Dalton recorded a double-double with 13 points and 12 rebounds. He is the first Poke since Derek Cooke, Jr. to record a double-double in back-to-back games since he did it against Nevada (1/31/15) and Colorado State (2/4/15).
  - Dalton entered the game leading UW in rebounds and assists per game. Tonight, Dalton led the Pokes with a game-high 12 rebounds, four assists and four steals.
  - Sophomore guard Justin James scored 27 points to lead all scorers. It marks James's seventh double-figure game of the season and second cracking the 20-point threshold.
  - James shot 9-of-16 from the field and 8-of-8 from the free throw line.
  - Senior guard Jason McManamen had 10 points for his ninth game in double figures this season and 37th of his career.
  - Sophomore forward Jordan Naughton had nine rebounds, for his most in a game since pulling down 14 boards in the Cowboys' season-opener against Western State.
