Cowboys Face DePaul in Las Vegas Classic

The Pokes head to Las Vegas for the final two rounds of Continental Tire Las Vegas Classic played at the Orleans Arena. UW faces off against DePaul of the Big East on Thursday in the first meeting between the schools since 1944 for a contest slated for a 6:30 p.m. MT start. The Cowboys will play the following day against No. 23/25 USC or Missouri State at a time to be determined.

First Round

Game 1- Wyoming vs. DePaul - 6: 30 p.m. MT - FS1

Game 2- No. 23/25 USC vs. Missouri State - 9:00 p.m. MT -FS1

Second Round

Game 1- Game 1 Loser vs. Game 2 Loser - 6: 30 p.m. MT - FS1

Game 2- Game 1 Winner vs. Game 2 Winner - 9:00 p.m. MT -FS1

The game will be broadcasted nationally on FS1 with Justin Kutcher providing the play-by-play and Steve Lavin on the color. The game will be broadcast live on radio over the 25 affiliate stations of the Cowboy Sports Network. Fans can follow live stats and listen to the contest on GoWyo.com.

A Look at the Matchup

The Cowboys head into Thursday's contest with a six-game winning streak after finishing off their six game homestand with an unblemished record. UW went 8-0 at home during the non-conference portion of their schedule. UW ranks No. 26 in the nation in field percentage defense at 38.2 percent. For the season, the Pokes are shooting 43 percent from the field and 33 percent from the three point line. UW leads the MW and ranks No. 52 in the nation in three point field goals per game at 9.2. Wyoming ranks No. 12 in the nation in defensive rebounds per game at 30.0.

The Blue Demons head to Vegas with 7-4 overall record after defeating Southeast Missouri State on Monday. DePaul is shooting 47 percent from the field on the season on their way to scoring 75.6 points per game. Opponents are shooting 42 percent from the field and 34 percent from the three point line against DePaul.

Each Team's Leaders

The Cowboys are led in scoring by sophomore guard Justin James. He is averaging 16.6 points per game on the season. James is shooting 49 percent from the field and adds 4.4 rebounds per game. Senior guard Jason McManamen is pouring in 14.8 points per game. He ranks fourth in the MW in three-pointers per game at 2.55, which ranks No. 116 nationally. Junior forward Alan Herndon is adding 10.5 points per game and 5.7 rebounds. He ranks second in the MW and No. 61 in the country in blocked shots per game at 1.82. Junior forward Hayden Dalton leads the team in rebounding at 7.5 per game, which ranks fifth in the MW. He also adds 11.4 points per night after scoring 27 points against Cornell last Saturday.

The Blue Demons are led in scoring by Eli Cain as he is averaging 20.5 points per game on the season. He is shooting 52 percent from the field and 46 percent from behind the three point line. Billy Garrett is second on the team in scoring at 14.3 per game. He also leads the team in assists with 40 on the season. Tre'Darius McCallum leads the team grabbing 7.5 rebounds per game.

About the Series

UW and DePaul have their all-time series tied at 1-1. The Cowboys last faced DePaul in 1944 in Chicago, Ill. The Blue Demons took the contest by a score of 66-29. The Cowboys defeated DePaul in Laramie by a score of 33-25 in 1930.

Up Next

The Cowboys will face either No. 23/25 USC or Missouri State on Friday in a time to be determined.

Last Recap: Cowboys Rally Past Troy

The Wyoming Cowboys erased a 10-point deficit in the second half to rally past Troy, 72-66 on Monday evening in one of the most unique games in the history of the Arena-Auditorium. The game featured a delay that lasted over two hours after a power outage in Laramie. The Pokes were led by sophomore guard Justin James, as he added a game-high 27 points. UW has now won six-straight games and is 8-0 at home this season.

"Tonight showed great character in our group," UW head coach Allen Edwards said. "We had these six games as a season within a season and going 6-0 achieved our goals. We talked about our guys having a laser like focus going into this game and even more so with what happened. It went up and down overall and at the end of the day it was a win."

James scored 19 of his 27 points in the second half to lead UW. He did most of his damage attacking the rim and finished the night going 8-for-8 from the free throw line. He fell just one point shy of his career-high. Junior forward Hayden Dalton recorded his second-straight double-double with 13 points and 12 rebounds. He is the first Poke since Derek Cooke, Jr. in 2015 to record a double-double in back-to-back contests.

Senior guard Jason McManamen added 10 points for his seventh game in double figures this season and 37th of his career. He also added six rebounds. Sophomore forward Jordan Naughton added eight points and nine rebounds on the night.

The Cowboys shot 40 percent (25-of-62) from the field and shot 44 percent in the second half. The Cowboys defense was strong holding Troy to 34 percent from the field. UW came into the game ranking No. 30 in the nation in field goal percentage defense at 39 percent.

Notes

Power Outage: The Cowboys played in a unique game on Monday night. The game against Troy featured a delay of over two hours due to a power outage in Laramie. It wasn't the first time that has happened to UW. The Pokes played at UMass in December 1996 in a game that featured a power outage that saw the game get played the next day.

What A Rally: The Cowboys erased a 10 point deficit in the second half to race past Troy 72-66 on Monday. It was the largest deficit overcame by the Cowboys this season. The most up to that point was nine at Montana. UW sealed the win by going 7-of-8 from the line in the closing minutes.

Double-Double Dalton: Junior forward Hayden Dalton recorded a double-double against Troy with 13 points and 12 rebounds. He recorded his second-straight double-double after recording one against Cornell. He is the first Poke since Derek Cooke, Jr. in 2015 to record a double-double in back-to-back contests.

How About This: The Pokes dominated the glass with 47 rebounds to the Trojans 38 on Monday. Troy came into the game ranking No. 14 in the nation in rebounding. The Cowboys grabbed a season-high 15 offensive boards.

Nice To See You Again: The Cowboys will face off against DePaul for the first time since 1944. The all-time series is tied at 1-1. The Cowboys have also not faced an opponent from the Big East since facing Providence in 2010-11 when the Pokes fell to the Friars 84-77 in Cancun, Mexico.

Sinking The Three Ball: The Cowboys head to Vegas leading the Mountain West and ranking 52nd in the nation in three pointers made per game at 9.2. Wyoming averaged 9.9 makes per game last season for first in the MW and 11th in the nation.

Getting Defensive: The Cowboys have done a great job defending from the field this season. Opponents are only shooting 38.2 percent from the field. That number leads the Mountain West and ranks 26th in the nation.

Crashing the Boards: The Pokes head into Monday's game averaging 30.0 defensive rebounds per game. That number leads the MW and ranks No. 12 in the nation this season. UW is grabbing 38.3 rebounds per game

Dalton Has Career Day: Junior forward Hayden Dalton scored a career-high 27 points and grabbed 11 rebounds in the Cowboys' win over Cornell. It was his second double-double of the season. Dalton poured in 21 points in the first half making him the first Cowboy to score 20 points in the opening half since Josh Adams scored 20 against Boise State in the semifinals of the 2015 MW Tournament.

Career Days: Four other Cowboys tied their career-best or recorded a career day against Cornell. Junior guard Louis Adams added a career-high 24 points for the Pokes against Cornell. He hit a career-high three triples in his first 20 point scoring game of his career. Redshirt freshman guard Cody Kelley added eight points for his third-straight Saturday game with a career-high eight points. Senior guard Morris Marshall added a career-high seven points and redshirt freshman Sam Averback scored a career-high two points. It was the second time this season two Cowboys have scored 20 or more points. Alexander Aka Gorski and Jordan Naughton scored 20 against Western State.

Did You Know: The Pokes scored 97 points last Saturday against Cornell. It was the most since scoring 101 last season against Bristol. It was the most points against an NCAA Division I opponent since scoring 97 against Texas State on Nov. 26, 2008. He Pokes scored 56 points in the first half the most since scoring 56 against Arkansas State on Nov. 16, 2013.

The Dish: The Pokes dished out 21 assists last Saturday against Cornell. Junior guard Jeremy Lieberman added a career-high seven assists along with a career-high five assists from Jason McManamen. UW is fourth in the MW in assists this season and No. 100 in the nation at 15.4 per game.

Balanced Attack: The Cowboys saw five players score in double-figures in their win over Montana. Senior guard Jason McManamen led the way with 20 points. Sophomore guard Justin James added 16 points, Junior forwards Hayden Dalton and Alan Herndon added 11 points and junior guard Louis Adams had 10. It was the first time five players scored in double-figures since UW defeated Northern Colorado in the season opener of the 2014-15 season.

Going Streaking: The Cowboys won six-straight contests during their six-game homestand. UW is holding opponents to 37.8 percent from the field during the winning streak. The Pokes are also hitting nearly 10 three pointers per game.

Home Cooking: The Cowboys are 8-0 at home this season. The Pokes are shooting 45 percent from the field and holding opponents to only 36 percent. The Cowboys have also hit 83 threes at home this season.

Big Al: Junior forward Alan Herndon scored a career-high 17 points against Pacific. He also tied a career-high with seven field goals and three triples. He added 11 points and nine rebounds against Cal and added 12 points and seven boards against Denver and added 12 points against UNI followed by 15 against Colo. Christian and 11 against Montana and Cornell. He has scored in double-figures in seven of his last eight games, as it is the longest streak of his career. Herndon has also protected the rim. He ranks second in the conference and 55th nationally in blocks per game at 1.9. He recorded a career-high four against Cornell.

McManamen Finds Groove: Senior guard Jason McManamen was solid against UNI hitting 6-of-7 three pointers and finishing the game with 21 points. He also added 20 points against Montana for fourth 20 point game of the season and the 10th of his career.

Cowboy Cavalry: The Pokes bench has been great this season adding an average of 32.8 points per game. The Pokes bench has added over 40 points in four of the last six games with 45 points against Denver and 41 against Northern Iowa and 40 against Montana and 40 against Troy. The 45 bench points was the most since UW scored 50 against San Diego State in 2010.

It is Charity for McManamen: Senior guard Jason McManamen scored a season-high 23 points at Pacific. He did most of his damage from the free throw line going 16-for-16. It was the most made free throws without a miss for the Cowboys since Jeron Roberts went 20-for-20 from the line against UTEP on Feb. 7, 1998. McManamen has made 51 free throws this season ranking 70th in the Nation.

Almost Free: The Cowboys have been solid from the free throw line this season. Wyoming is shooting 74 percent from the line going 207-of-281. That percentage ranks fourth in the conference and No. 70 in the nation.

Watch Out for James: Sophomore Justin James has been outstanding for the Pokes this season. He is averaging a team best 16.6 points per game. He scored a career-high 28 points at Cal for his first 20 point game of his career. He is also added 21 against Denver and 27 against Troy scoring 10 points in the closing minutes and 19 in the second half.

Raining Threes: The Cowboys hit 16 threes in their win over UNI. It was the third most in school history and the second most in the history of the Arena-Auditorium. The Cowboys shot 55 percent from behind the arc in the game hitting 16-of-29 attempts. It was the highest three point percentage in the Arena-Auditorium since hitting 11-of-19 three for 58 percent against Lehigh on March 19, 2013.

Draining Shots: The Cowboys shot 54 percent from the field against UNI hitting 26-of-48 shots. It was the highest field goal percentage of the season and marked the second time this season (Western State) UW has shot over 50 percent from the field. The Panthers came into Saturday's game as one of the top scoring defenses in the country.

Double-Double Tandem: Junior Hayden Dalton recorded a double-double against Montana scoring 11 points and grabbing 13 rebounds for his first career double-double. In the season opener against Western State, sophomore Jordan Naughton recorded a double-double with 20 points and 14 rebounds. It marked the first time that two different Cowboys recorded a double-double in back-to-back games since Derek Cooke Jr. did it against Nevada on Jan. 31, 2015 and Larry Nance Jr. against Colorado State on Feb. 4, 2015.

Naughton Has Career Day: Junior forward Jordan Naughton had a career night against Western State. He had career-highs in points with 20 and rebounds with 14. He had a double-double in the first half with 12 points and 11 boards. He became the first Cowboy in the Mountain West era to record a double-double in the first half. It also marked the seventh time in the MW era that a Cowboy has recorded 10 rebounds in a half. The last was Larry Nance Jr., as he recorded 10 at SMU in 2014-15.

2016-17 WYOMING GAME NOTES

Head Coach Allen Edwards



Allen Edwards was introduced as the 21st head coach of the Cowboy basketball program by University of Wyoming Athletics Director Tom Burman on March 21, 2016. He had previously served as an assistant under former UW head coach Larry Shyatt the previous five seasons. With 12 appearances in postseason tournaments and 14 conference championships, Edwards has created success during his playing career at Kentucky and as an assistant the past 14 seasons.

"An institution is fortunate when it has the opportunity to hire its next head coach from within a successful program," Burman said at the time of Edwards' hiring. "Larry Shyatt's Cowboy basketball

legacy has allowed us to do that. We are thrilled to place its future in the hands of Allen Edwards. His basketball pedigree is undeniable, including two national championships with one of the game's most storied programs, Kentucky. He has coached with, and played under some of the game's finest coaches. During his five years here, his impact on our program has been significant, while earning the respect of our players. We believe Wyoming basketball has an extremely bright future."

"This opportunity to lead the Wyoming Cowboys is a blessing I'm truly thankful for," Edwards said. "I'd like to thank Larry Shyatt for bringing me to Laramie and allowing me to grow and develop as a professional with his help. My gratitude to Tom Burman, as well, for the faith that I can continue the tradition of success in the game of basketball and the game of life that Larry has established for this program."

Since joining the program in 2011, Edwards has helped the Pokes compile an overall record of 98-69. He added to his extensive postseason experience with the Cowboys qualifying for the CBI from 2012-14 and the NCAA Championships in 2015. That 2014-15 season included winning the Mountain West tournament title to secure the Pokes' first appearance in the NCAA tournament since 2002. During his time in Laramie, the Cowboys have claimed six wins over top-25 opponents, including one against a top-five foe, and six players have earned 15 all-conference honors, including a MW Player of the Year and two MW Defensive Players of the Year. He helped coach Larry Nance Jr., who was picked 27th overall in the first round of last year's NBA draft by the Los Angeles Lakers. Edwards also took the reins for one game on Jan. 22, 2014, to lead Wyoming to a come-from-behind 66-59 win at Air Force when Shyatt was ill.

"I want to congratulate coach Shyatt on the outstanding job he did at Wyoming," Nance said. "He took a 10-win program to nearly four-straight seasons with 20 wins. It's awesome to see him get some time to relax for a little bit. He's earned that. In the same breath, he couldn't be handing off the program to a more capable person. Coach Edwards is one of the smartest basketball minds I know, even at the NBA level. How he handles his players and staff, he commands respect and he deserves it. Allen is the right man for the job and he will continue the success there at Wyoming."

Edwards came to Wyoming from Western Kentucky, where he spent the 2010-11 season under Ken McDonald as an assistant coach. The Hilltoppers finished 16-16 overall, including 8-8 in the Sun Belt Conference, with a pair of first team all-conference players. Prior to WKU, Edwards spent 2009-10 as an assistant at Towson University under head coach Pat Kennedy.

Those two positions for Edwards came after a very productive three-year stint at Virginia Commonwealth University with head coach Anthony Grant from 2006-09. He helped guide the Rams to a 76-25 overall record during that time, including 45-9 in the Colonial Athletic Association, as the Rams won three conference regular-season titles and two tournament titles. VCU played in the NCAA tournament twice, including a first-round upset of Duke in 2007, and the NIT once. During that 2006-07 season, the Rams led the nation in three-point field goal percentage defense and were 10th in field goal percentage defense. Edwards helped cultivate Eric Maynor, the 20th overall pick in the 2009 NBA draft, and Larry Sanders, the 15th overall selection in the 2010 NBA draft.

Edwards' first full-time assistant position was at Morehead State from 2003-06 under head coach Kyle Macy. He previously spent the 2002-03 as a special assistant to head coach Tubby Smith at Kentucky, as he returned to complete his degree in sociology. During that season, the Wildcats went 16-0 in the SEC to win the conference regular season and

tournament and advance to the NCAA's Elite Eight.

Edwards enjoyed a tremendous playing career at Kentucky from 1995-98 that included three seasons under Rick Pitino and one under Smith. The Wildcats advanced to three-straight Final Fours during Edwards' sophomore, junior and senior seasons, including winning national titles in 1996 and 1998. During his freshman campaign, Kentucky made the Elite Eight. With Edwards, the Wildcats compiled a 132-16 overall record and won three SEC regular-season crowns and three tournament titles. He averaged 9.2 points, 3.3 assists and 3.3 rebounds as a senior. Following his collegiate career, Edwards played professionally in the CBA and the IBL.

A native of Miami, Edwards played his prep career at Miami Senior High School where he and his two brothers collected five prep state titles. Allen is married to the former LaTanya Webb, a two-time All-SEC volleyball player at Kentucky. They have two daughters, Mai'a (15) and Landree (4), and a son, Jaxson (8). Edwards will be 40 years old when the 2016-17 season starts.

2016-17 WYOMING GAME NOTES

Assistant Coach Jeremy Shyatt



Jeremy Shyatt begins his sixth season as an assistant coach for Wyoming during 2016-17. The oldest son of former head coach Larry Shyatt, Jeremy helped guide the Cowboys to a 25-10 overall record during the 2014-15 campaign for a Mountain West tournament title and Wyoming's first berth in the NCAA tournament since 2001-02. Shyatt was at North Florida for two seasons prior to coming to UW.

At North Florida, Shyatt assisted head coach Matthew Driscoll, who was an assistant at Wyoming during the 1997-98 season under Larry. During his time

with the Ospreys, Shyatt helped build a resurgence of the basketball program. North Florida won 28 games in the two years, after having won just 22 total games in the four years prior to that.

In 2010-11, UNF finished 15-19 overall and 10-10 in the Atlantic Sun Conference. The 15 wins matched the most in school history and the 10 conference wins also set a school record. The Ospreys fell one game short of the NCAA Tournament, losing to Belmont in the Atlantic Sun Championship game. It marked the first time that North Florida had played in a conference championship game. In addition, North

Florida won the Mayan Division of the 2010 Cancun Challenge. Prior to their trip to Cancun, the Ospreys traveled to Wyoming and beat the Cowboys in the Arena-Auditorium.

At UNF, Shyatt was involved in many facets of the program including on-court coaching, recruiting, opponent scouting, team academic progress, housing, camps, skill development and was the team's video coordinator. He helped design the team's basketball locker room, and oversaw their Nike account and student-managers.

Prior to taking the job at UNF, Shyatt spent two seasons at Virginia Commonwealth University as the team's Director of Basketball Operations. During his stint at VCU, the Rams won two regular-season conference championships, advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2009 and earned an NIT berth in 2008. He helped coach Eric Maynor, the 20th overall selection in the 2009 NBA draft and Larry Sanders, the 15th overall selection in the 2010 NBA draft.

Shyatt held the same Director of Basketball Operations title at East Carolina University from 2005-07.

From 2003-05, Shyatt was a volunteer assistant coach at the University of South Carolina. There, he earned a master's degree in integrated communication and advertising.

From 2002-05, Shyatt served as director of the Boys and Girls Summer Day Camps with the NBA's Cleveland Cavaliers.

Assistant Coach Tony Pujol



University of Wyoming men's basketball head coach Allen Edwards completed his 2016-17 staff April 19 with the hiring of Tony Pujol as an assistant coach. Pujol previously spent time at Alabama and VCU.

Pujol last coached collegiately at Alabama for five seasons from 2010-2014 under head coach Anthony Grant. Pujol helped the Crimson Tide compile a 99-71 record during his time on the staff, including three-straight 20-win seasons for the first time since 1990-92. Alabama earned two NIT bids and one NCAA bid from 2011-13 and finished runner-up in the NIT in 2011.

That 2010-11 Crimson Tide team featured one of the toughest defenses in the nation, as Alabama surrendered only 59.4 points per game, the eighth-lowest average in the nation. Alabama's tenacious defense helped it go 19-0 at home during that season. On the recruiting trail, he helped the Tide land a 2011 recruiting class that Rivals.com ranked as the fifth best in the nation with four prospects ranked in the top 100 nationally. After the 2013-14 season, Pujol

stepped away from collegiate coaching to dedicate more time to his family and has coached the last year and a half in the AAU ranks in New Jersey.

Previously, Pujol served under Grant at VCU from 2006-09 with Edwards and Jeremy Shyatt. The staff guided the Rams to a 76-25 record in those three seasons, including 45-9 in the Colonial Athletic Association. VCU won three conference regular-season titles and two tournament titles in that span to play in the NCAA tournament twice and NIT once. Two Rams from that team, Eric Maynor and Larry Sanders, would go on to be selected in the NBA draft. Pujol joined Grant's staff after two seasons at Appalachian State from 2004-06, where he helped the Mountaineers win the Southern Conference North Division in 2005. The team also earned the NCAA's Public Recognition Award based on the program's APR. His recruits would help ASU win a school-record 25 games the season after he left.

Prior to his collegiate career, Pujol was a high school coach in south Florida for 13 seasons, including nine at Northwest Christian Academy in Miami, where he posted a 250-46 record with state titles in 1999, 2003 and 2004. He graduated from Sterling College (Kansas) in 1989 with a degree in business administration and was a standout in both basketball and baseball, earning all-conference honors on the diamond in his final three seasons.

Assistant Coach Jermaine Kimbrough



University of Wyoming men's basketball head coach Allen Edwards announced April 14 the hiring of Jermaine Kimbrough as an assistant coach. Kimbrough came to Laramie from Nevada and Cleveland State.

Kimbrough spent the 2015-16 season under head coach Eric Musselman at Nevada. The first-year staff guided the Wolf Pack to a 24-14 overall record, including a 10-8 mark in the conference for fourth in the Mountain West regular-season standings. More importantly, Nevada accepted a bid to the CBI and won the tournament for the MW's first postseason title in men's basketball. With

Kimbrough's help, two Wolf Pack players earned four All-MW honors, including freshman forward Cameron Oliver being named to the All-MW Third Team, All-Defensive Team and All-Tournament Team.

Kimbrough came to Nevada after nine seasons from 2006-14 as an assistant under head coach Gary Waters at Cleveland State. During that time he helped the Vikings to a pair of Horizon League Championships, one NCAA tournament, three NIT trips and a CollegenInsider.com Tournament appearance. Cleveland State had five 20-wins campaigns

in Kimbrough's nine seasons with a 157-112 overall record. He also coached Norris Cole at CSU, who was selected in the 2011 NBA draft.

Kimbrough's coaching career started at the NJCAA's Howard College where he spent two seasons as an assistant from 2001-03. He moved on to serve as Director of Operations at Cleveland State in 2003-04 and Massachusetts in 2004-05. During that season the Minutemen knocked off No. 2 Connecticut, No. 20 George Washington and No. 23 Florida State. Kimbrough would move on to serve as an assistant coach for one season at IPFW before returning to Cleveland State.

During his playing career, Kimbrough spent two seasons at St. Catherine College, before transferring to Virginia Tech for two seasons from 1998-2000. He would go on to graduate from Virginia Tech with his bachelor's degree in psychology in 2001.

Kimbrough played his prep career at Shaker Heights High School in Cleveland and earned all-league honors four times and all-city accolades three times. He was named second-team all-state as a senior after averaging 26 points per game.

Jermaine and his wife, Tameka, have five children.


