Cowboys Continue Road Swing Heading to Fresno State

The Cowboys continue their brief road swing visiting defending Mountain West Tournament Champion Fresno State on Wednesday evening in the Save Mart Center in Fresno, Calif. The contest, slated for a 8 p.m. MT start will be the 24th meeting between the two schools.

The game will be broadcast live on radio over the 25 affiliate stations of the Cowboy Sports Network. Fans can follow live stats, listen and watch the contest on GoWyo.com.

A Look at the Matchup

The Cowboys (11-4, 1-1 MW) are coming off a 81-75 loss at UNLV last Saturday afternoon. The Pokes defense has been solid this season. UW leads the MW and ranks third in the nation in defensive rebounds per game at 31.53. The Pokes lead the MW and are No. 34 in the nation in total rebounds at 40.40 per game. Wyoming leads the MW and ranks No. 16 in the nation in field goal percentage defense at 37.8 percent. The Cowboys lead the MW in three pointers per game at 9.3, a number that ranks No. 45 in the nation.

The Bulldogs are 9-5 overall and 1-1 in Mountain West play after defeating Nevada 77-76 last Saturday in the Save Mart Center. The Bulldogs lead the MW in field goal percentage at 48.1, which rank No. 36 in the nation. The Bulldogs rank third in the MW in three point percentage at 36.3. The Bulldogs are 10th in the MW in rebounds at 35.6. The Bulldogs lead the conference in steals per game at 8.8, which ranks No. 22 in the nation.

Each Team's Leaders

The Cowboys are led in scoring by sophomore guard Justin James. He is averaging 16.6 points per game on the season ranking sixth in the MW. James is shooting 47 percent from the field and adds 5.0 rebounds per game. Senior guard Jason McManamen is pouring in 14.0 points per game, which ranks 11th in the MW. He ranks third in the MW in three pointers made this season with 40, which ranks No. 61 in the country. Junior forward Alan Herndon is adding 10.4 points per game and 5.9 rebounds. He ranks second in the MW and No. 30 in the country in blocked shots with 31. Junior forward Hayden Dalton leads the team in rebounding at 8.5 per game, which ranks third in the MW. He ranks No. 32 in the nation in defensive rebounds per game at 6.93. He also adds 12.8 points per night.

The Bulldogs are led in scoring by guard/forward Paul Watson. He is averaging 13.4 points per game and adds 5.2 rebounds. He is shooting 42 percent from the three point line. Guard Jaron Hopkins adds 12.9 points shooting 49 percent from the field. He leads the conference in steals per game at 2.3. Guard Jahmel Taylor leads the conference shooting 52 percent from behind the arc and is second in the league averaging 2.9 three pointers per game.

About the Series

The Cowboys trail the all-time series with Fresno State 9-14. The Pokes are 1-10 all-time in Fresno. Fresno State has won three-straight contests with the Pokes last win coming in triple overtime at Fresno State on Jan. 17, 2015.

Up Next

The Pokes return to action next Wednesday evening hosting Utah State in the Arena-Auditorium for a 7 p.m. Start. The game will also be broadcasted on ROOT Sports.

Last Recap: Turnovers Hurt Cowboys in Loss at UNLV

The Cowboys committed 12 second half turnovers in an 81-75 loss to UNLV on Saturday afternoon in the Thomas & Mack Center in Las Vegas, Nev. The Cowboys erased an 11-point deficit to tie the contest in the second half, but UW finished the game 5-of-26 from behind the arc for 19 percent. UW moves to 11-4 on the year and 1-1 in MW play. UNLV improves to 8-7 overall and 1-1 in the MW.

"We had opportunities and defended well, but just turned the ball over too much," UW head coach Allen Edwards said. "It is a process and I was proud of the effort tonight, just came up short. We we're just careless with the basketball and that led to empty possessions late."

The Cowboys were led in scoring by sophomore guard Justin James with 17 points. He was effective from the free throw line going 9-of-11. Junior forward Hayden Dalton recorded 16 points in his seven-straight game in double figures. He also added a team-high nine rebounds for the Pokes. Juniors Alexander Aka Gorski and Alan Herndon added 12 points each. Guard Jeremy Lieberman scored a season-high nine points. Senior guard Jason McManamen's 37-game streak recording at least one three pointer was snapped.

"Jeremy's (Lieberman) energy was contagious," Edwards said. "I felt what he did today helped us and allowed for him to play more minutes tonight. The free throws and three ball didn't fall tonight and we have to go back to the drawing board facing a tough Fresno State team next week."

The Pokes shot 45 percent from the field on the night going 27-of-60. The Pokes shot 58 percent from the field in the second half. UNLV shot 39 percent (25-of-64) from the field and 32 percent (7-of-22 from behind the arc. The Runnin' Rebels held the advantage on the boards 44-40.

Notes

Cleaning Up The Boards: The Cowboys have found success on the boards this season. UW leads the MW and ranks No. 34 in the nation in total rebounds at 40.40 per game. UW also ranks No. 3 in the nation in defensive rebounds per game at 31.5, as they also lead the conference in that category.

Getting Defensive: The Cowboys have done a great job defending from the field this season. Opponents are only allowing the opposition to shoot 37.8 percent from the field. That number leads the Mountain West and ranks No. 16 in the nation. The Cowboys have held opponents to under 40 percent from the field nine times this season. DePaul was held to 28 percent from the field for the lowest opponent shooting percentage. The field goal percentage defense by the Pokes this season is the best UW percentage in the MW era.

Back to Cali: The Cowboys head to California for the second time this season. The Pokes made a road swing earlier this season falling to Pacific and Cal. Four Cowboys hail from the Golden State.

Did You Know: The Cowboys are grabbing 40.4 rebounds per game this season. The last time a Cowboy team averaged 40 or more rebounds per game was during the 2001 season, as The Cowboys grabbed 40.2 rebounds per contest in 31 games.

Almost Free: The Cowboys have been solid from the free throw line this season. Wyoming is shooting 75 percent from the line going 276-of-370. That percentage is second in the MW and is No. 48 in the nation. If the season were to end today, it would be the best free throw percentage for UW in the MW era of Cowboy basketball.

Cowboy Cavalry: The Pokes bench has been great this season adding an average of 35 points per game. The Pokes bench has added over 40 points in seven of the last nine games with 45 points against Denver and 41 against Northern Iowa and 40 against Montana and 40 against Troy, 45 against DePaul and 44 vs. USC. The Cavalry had 42 against Air Force. The 45 bench points was the most since UW scored 50 against San Diego State in 2010. The UW bench had 33 points at UNLV, it was the first time they have not reached 40 points since scoring 19 against Cornell.

Balanced Attack: The Cowboys saw five players score in double-figures against Air Force. It was the second time this season UW has done so as the Pokes had five players score 10 or more points against Montana in Laramie in December. Junior forwards Hayden Dalton and Alan Herndon led UW in scoring with 15 points. Junior guard Alexander Aka Gorski and sophomore guard Justin James added 14 points. Senior guard Jason McManamen added 11 points. Both Aka Gorski and McManamen also handed out a career-high six assists. Redshirt freshman Andrew Moemeka added a career-high eight points. All his points come via the dunk. The Pokes had four players score in double figures against UNLV.

Going streaking: Senior guard Jason McManamen has been one of the most dangerous three point shooters in the country. He had three triples against Air Force, but failed to hit a three pointer against UNLV as his 37 consecutive game streak dating back to Dec. 5 of last season of hitting a three pointer was snapped.

HD Rebound Machine: Junior forward Hayden Dalton has been on a tear on the boards in recent weeks. He grabbed a career-high 18 against No. 23 USC. It was the most since Adam Waddell grabbed 22 against Utah on Jan. 10, 2010. He currently ranks third in the MW and No. 43 in the nation in total rebounds at 127. He also ranks second in the league and No. 44 in the country in double-doubles with five on the year. He had his four game double-double streak snapped against Air Force.

Here is the Dish: The Pokes dished out 21 assists against Air Force. UW has 20 or more assists four times this season. The 21 assists against Air Force is tied for second-most this season, as UW recorded 22 against UNI. Senior guard Jason McManamen and junior guard Alexander Aka Gorski added a career-high six assists each.

Moemeka Has Career Day: Redshirt freshman forward Andrew Moemeka recorded a career-high eight points against Air Force. He also played a career-high 13 minutes. All of his points came via the dunk. He also added two steals and one block to go along with six rebounds against the Falcons.

Hitting the Triple: The Cowboys hit 14 three pointers against Air Force on Wednesday. The 14 triples are tied for third most in a single game in school history. It is also tied for the fourth-most three point field goals in Arena-Auditorium history.

Comeback Kids: The Cowboys have been the "Comeback Kids" recently. The Cowboys trailed both Troy and DePaul by 10 points in their last two wins. It was the largest deficit overcome by the Cowboys this season. UW trailed by 10 to DePaul in the first half and trailed Troy by 10 in the second half of the ball game. The Cowboys trailed by 11 points at UNLV and came back to tie the game, but failed to pickup the win.

JMac attack: Senior guard Jason McManamen hit six three pointers against USC tying a season-best. He hit five in the first half, the most since Josh Adams hit five against Marshall last season. He is third in the MW and No. 61 in the nation in three pointers made this season at 40.

Sinking The Three Ball: The Cowboys head to Fresno leading the Mountain West and ranking No. 45 in the nation in three pointers made per game at 9.3. Wyoming averaged 9.9 makes per game last season for first in the MW and 11th in the nation.

Home Cooking: The Cowboys are 9-0 at home this season. The Pokes are shooting 45 percent from the field and holding opponents to only 36 percent. The Cowboys have also hit 97 threes at home this season.

Dalton Has Career Day: Junior forward Hayden Dalton scored a career-high 27 points and grabbed 11 rebounds in the Cowboys' win over Cornell. It was his second double-double of the season and started a four-straight double-double streak for him. Dalton poured in 21 points in the first half making him the first Cowboy to score 20 points in the opening half since Josh Adams scored 20 against Boise State in the semifinals of the 2015 MW Tournament.

Career Days: Four other Cowboys tied their career-best or recorded a career day against Cornell. Junior guard Louis Adams added a career-high 24 points for the Pokes against Cornell. He hit a career-high three triples in his first 20 point scoring game of his career. Redshirt freshman guard Cody Kelley added eight points for his third-straight Saturday game with a career-high eight points. Senior guard Morris Marshall added a career-high seven points and redshirt freshman Sam Averbuck scored a career-high two points. It was the second time this season two Cowboys have scored 20 or more points. Alexander Aka Gorski and Jordan Naughton scored 20 against Western State.

Did You Know: The Pokes scored 97 points last against Cornell. It was the most since scoring 101 last season against Bristol. It was the most points against an NCAA Division I opponent since scoring 97 against Texas State on Nov. 26, 2008. He Pokes scored 56 points in the first half the most since scoring 56 against Arkansas State on Nov. 16, 2013.

Big Al: Junior forward Alan Herndon scored a career-high 17 points against Pacific. He also tied a career-high with seven field goals and three triples. Herndon has also protected the rim. He ranks third in the conference and 42nd nationally in blocks per game at 2.07. He recorded a career-high four against Cornell and UNLV.

It is Charity for McManamen: Senior guard Jason McManamen scored a season-high 23 points at Pacific. He did most of his damage from the free throw line going 16-for-16. It was the most made free throws without a miss for the Cowboys since Jeron Roberts went 20-for-20 from the line against UTEP on Feb. 7, 1998.

Watch Out for James: Sophomore Justin James has been outstanding for the Pokes this season. He is averaging a team best 16.6 points per game. He scored a career-high 28 points at Cal for his first 20 point game of his career. He is also added 21 against Denver and 27 against Troy scoring 10 points in the closing minutes and 19 in the second half.

Raining Threes: The Cowboys hit 16 threes in their win over UNI. It was the third most in school history and the second most in the history of the Arena-Auditorium. The Cowboys shot 55 percent from behind the arc in the game hitting 16-of-29 attempts. It was the highest three point percentage in the Arena-Auditorium since hitting 11-of-19 three for 58 percent against Lehigh on March 19, 2013.

Draining Shots: The Cowboys shot 54 percent from the field against UNI hitting 26-of-48 shots. It was the highest field goal percentage of the season and marked the second time this season (Western State) UW has shot over 50 percent from the field. The Panthers came into Saturday's game as one of the top scoring defenses in the country.

2016-17 WYOMING GAME NOTES

Head Coach Allen Edwards



Allen Edwards was introduced as the 21st head coach of the Cowboy basketball program by University of Wyoming Athletics Director Tom Burman on March 21, 2016. He had previously served as an assistant under former UW head coach Larry Shyatt the previous five seasons. With 12 appearances in postseason tournaments and 14 conference championships, Edwards has created success during his playing career at Kentucky and as an assistant the past 14 seasons.

"An institution is fortunate when it has the opportunity to hire its next head coach from within a successful program," Burman said at the time of Edwards' hiring. "Larry Shyatt's Cowboy basketball

legacy has allowed us to do that. We are thrilled to place its future in the hands of Allen Edwards. His basketball pedigree is undeniable, including two national championships with one of the game's most storied programs, Kentucky. He has coached with, and played under some of the game's finest coaches. During his five years here, his impact on our program has been significant, while earning the respect of our players. We believe Wyoming basketball has an extremely bright future."

"This opportunity to lead the Wyoming Cowboys is a blessing I'm truly thankful for," Edwards said. "I'd like to thank Larry Shyatt for bringing me to Laramie and allowing me to grow and develop as a professional with his help. My gratitude to Tom Burman, as well, for the faith that I can continue the tradition of success in the game of basketball and the game of life that Larry has established for this program."

Since joining the program in 2011, Edwards has helped the Pokes compile an overall record of 98-69. He added to his extensive postseason experience with the Cowboys qualifying for the CBI from 2012-14 and the NCAA Championships in 2015. That 2014-15 season included winning the Mountain West tournament title to secure the Pokes' first appearance in the NCAA tournament since 2002. During his time in Laramie, the Cowboys have claimed six wins over top-25 opponents, including one against a top-five foe, and six players have earned 15 all-conference honors, including a MW Player of the Year and two MW Defensive Players of the Year. He helped coach Larry Nance Jr., who was picked 27th overall in the first round of last year's NBA draft by the Los Angeles Lakers. Edwards also took the reins for one game on Jan. 22, 2014, to lead Wyoming to a come-from-behind 66-59 win at Air Force when Shyatt was ill.

"I want to congratulate coach Shyatt on the outstanding job he did at Wyoming," Nance said. "He took a 10-win program to nearly four-straight seasons with 20 wins. It's awesome to see him get some time to relax for a little bit. He's earned that. In the same breath, he couldn't be handing off the program to a more capable person. Coach Edwards is one of the smartest basketball minds I know, even at the NBA level. How he handles his players and staff, he commands respect and he deserves it. Allen is the right man for the job and he will continue the success there at Wyoming."

Edwards came to Wyoming from Western Kentucky, where he spent the 2010-11 season under Ken McDonald as an assistant coach. The Hilltoppers finished 16-16 overall, including 8-8 in the Sun Belt Conference, with a pair of first team all-conference players. Prior to WKU, Edwards spent 2009-10 as an assistant at Towson University under head coach Pat Kennedy.

Those two positions for Edwards came after a very productive three-year stint at Virginia Commonwealth University with head coach Anthony Grant from 2006-09. He helped guide the Rams to a 76-25 overall record during that time, including 45-9 in the Colonial Athletic Association, as the Rams won three conference regular-season titles and two tournament titles. VCU played in the NCAA tournament twice, including a first-round upset of Duke in 2007, and the NIT once. During that 2006-07 season, the Rams led the nation in three-point field goal percentage defense and were 10th in field goal percentage defense. Edwards helped cultivate Eric Maynor, the 20th overall pick in the 2009 NBA draft, and Larry Sanders, the 15th overall selection in the 2010 NBA draft.

Edwards' first full-time assistant position was at Morehead State from 2003-06 under head coach Kyle Macy. He previously spent the 2002-03 as a special assistant to head coach Tubby Smith at Kentucky, as he returned to complete his degree in sociology. During that season, the Wildcats went 16-0 in the SEC to win the conference regular season and

tournament and advance to the NCAA's Elite Eight.

Edwards enjoyed a tremendous playing career at Kentucky from 1995-98 that included three seasons under Rick Pitino and one under Smith. The Wildcats advanced to three-straight Final Fours during Edwards' sophomore, junior and senior seasons, including winning national titles in 1996 and 1998. During his freshman campaign, Kentucky made the Elite Eight. With Edwards, the Wildcats compiled a 132-16 overall record and won three SEC regular-season crowns and three tournament titles. He averaged 9.2 points, 3.3 assists and 3.3 rebounds as a senior. Following his collegiate career, Edwards played professionally in the CBA and the IBL.

A native of Miami, Edwards played his prep career at Miami Senior High School where he and his two brothers collected five prep state titles. Allen is married to the former LaTanya Webb, a two-time All-SEC volleyball player at Kentucky. They have two daughters, Mai'a (15) and Landree (4), and a son, Jaxson (8). Edwards will be 40 years old when the 2016-17 season starts.

2016-17 WYOMING GAME NOTES

Assistant Coach Jeremy Shyatt



Jeremy Shyatt begins his sixth season as an assistant coach for Wyoming during 2016-17. The oldest son of former head coach Larry Shyatt, Jeremy helped guide the Cowboys to a 25-10 overall record during the 2014-15 campaign for a Mountain West tournament title and Wyoming's first berth in the NCAA tournament since 2001-02. Shyatt was at North Florida for two seasons prior to coming to UW.

At North Florida, Shyatt assisted head coach Matthew Driscoll, who was an assistant at Wyoming during the 1997-98 season under Larry. During his time

with the Ospreys, Shyatt helped build a resurgence of the basketball program. North Florida won 28 games in the two years, after having won just 22 total games in the four years prior to that.

In 2010-11, UNF finished 15-19 overall and 10-10 in the Atlantic Sun Conference. The 15 wins matched the most in school history and the 10 conference wins also set a school record. The Ospreys fell one game short of the NCAA Tournament, losing to Belmont in the Atlantic Sun Championship game. It marked the first time that North Florida had played in a conference championship game. In addition, North

Florida won the Mayan Division of the 2010 Cancun Challenge. Prior to their trip to Cancun, the Ospreys traveled to Wyoming and beat the Cowboys in the Arena-Auditorium.

At UNF, Shyatt was involved in many facets of the program including on-court coaching, recruiting, opponent scouting, team academic progress, housing, camps, skill development and was the team's video coordinator. He helped design the team's basketball locker room, and oversaw their Nike account and student-managers.

Prior to taking the job at UNF, Shyatt spent two seasons at Virginia Commonwealth University as the team's Director of Basketball Operations. During his stint at VCU, the Rams won two regular-season conference championships, advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2009 and earned an NIT berth in 2008. He helped coach Eric Maynor, the 20th overall selection in the 2009 NBA draft and Larry Sanders, the 15th overall selection in the 2010 NBA draft.

Shyatt held the same Director of Basketball Operations title at East Carolina University from 2005-07.

From 2003-05, Shyatt was a volunteer assistant coach at the University of South Carolina. There, he earned a master's degree in integrated communication and advertising.

From 2002-05, Shyatt served as director of the Boys and Girls Summer Day Camps with the NBA's Cleveland Cavaliers.

Assistant Coach Tony Pujol



University of Wyoming men's basketball head coach Allen Edwards completed his 2016-17 staff April 19 with the hiring of Tony Pujol as an assistant coach. Pujol previously spent time at Alabama and VCU.

Pujol last coached collegiately at Alabama for five seasons from 2010-2014 under head coach Anthony Grant. Pujol helped the Crimson Tide compile a 99-71 record during his time on the staff, including three-straight 20-win seasons for the first time since 1990-92. Alabama earned two NIT bids and one NCAA bid from 2011-13 and finished runner-up in the NIT in 2011.

That 2010-11 Crimson Tide team featured one of the toughest defenses in the nation, as Alabama surrendered only 59.4 points per game, the eighth-lowest average in the nation. Alabama's tenacious defense helped it go 19-0 at home during that season. On the recruiting trail, he helped the Tide land a 2011 recruiting class that Rivals.com ranked as the fifth best in the nation with four prospects ranked in the top 100 nationally. After the 2013-14 season, Pujol

stepped away from collegiate coaching to dedicate more time to his family and has coached the last year and a half in the AAU ranks in New Jersey.

Previously, Pujol served under Grant at VCU from 2006-09 with Edwards and Jeremy Shyatt. The staff guided the Rams to a 76-25 record in those three seasons, including 45-9 in the Colonial Athletic Association. VCU won three conference regular-season titles and two tournament titles in that span to play in the NCAA tournament twice and NIT once. Two Rams from that team, Eric Maynor and Larry Sanders, would go on to be selected in the NBA draft. Pujol joined Grant's staff after two seasons at Appalachian State from 2004-06, where he helped the Mountaineers win the Southern Conference North Division in 2005. The team also earned the NCAA's Public Recognition Award based on the program's APR. His recruits would help ASU win a school-record 25 games the season after he left.

Prior to his collegiate career, Pujol was a high school coach in south Florida for 13 seasons, including nine at Northwest Christian Academy in Miami, where he posted a 250-46 record with state titles in 1999, 2003 and 2004. He graduated from Sterling College (Kansas) in 1989 with a degree in business administration and was a standout in both basketball and baseball, earning all-conference honors on the diamond in his final three seasons.

Assistant Coach Jermaine Kimbrough



University of Wyoming men's basketball head coach Allen Edwards announced April 14 the hiring of Jermaine Kimbrough as an assistant coach. Kimbrough came to Laramie from Nevada and Cleveland State.

Kimbrough spent the 2015-16 season under head coach Eric Musselman at Nevada. The first-year staff guided the Wolf Pack to a 24-14 overall record, including a 10-8 mark in the conference for fourth in the Mountain West regular-season standings. More importantly, Nevada accepted a bid to the CBI and won the tournament for the MW's first postseason title in men's basketball. With

Kimbrough's help, two Wolf Pack players earned four All-MW honors, including freshman forward Cameron Oliver being named to the All-MW Third Team, All-Defensive Team and All-Tournament Team.

Kimbrough came to Nevada after nine seasons from 2006-14 as an assistant under head coach Gary Waters at Cleveland State. During that time he helped the Vikings to a pair of Horizon League Championships, one NCAA tournament, three NIT trips and a CollegenInsider.com Tournament appearance. Cleveland State had five 20-wins campaigns

in Kimbrough's nine seasons with a 157-112 overall record. He also coached Norris Cole at CSU, who was selected in the 2011 NBA draft.

Kimbrough's coaching career started at the NJCAA's Howard College where he spent two seasons as an assistant from 2001-03. He moved on to serve as Director of Operations at Cleveland State in 2003-04 and Massachusetts in 2004-05. During that season the Minutemen knocked off No. 2 Connecticut, No. 20 George Washington and No. 23 Florida State. Kimbrough would move on to serve as an assistant coach for one season at IPFW before returning to Cleveland State.

During his playing career, Kimbrough spent two seasons at St. Catherine College, before transferring to Virginia Tech for two seasons from 1998-2000. He would go on to graduate from Virginia Tech with his bachelor's degree in psychology in 2001.

Kimbrough played his prep career at Shaker Heights High School in Cleveland and earned all-league honors four times and all-city accolades three times. He was named second-team all-state as a senior after averaging 26 points per game.

Jermaine and his wife, Tameka, have five children.


