UTAH STATE BEGINNING TWO-GAME ROAD TRIP AT WYOMING ON WEDNESDAY

- Wyoming owns a 48-26 advantage all-time in a series that dates back to 1925-26 and is the seventh-longest in Utah State history.

- Utah State has lost six of the last seven games at Wyoming with its last victory coming on Feb. 16, 1962.

THINGS OF NOTE

- Senior wing **Jalen Moore** has scored in double figures in 28 consecutive games and needs three more games in double figures to tie the ninth-longest streak of double-digit outings in school history.

- Moore** is currently No. 16 on the all-time scoring list at Utah State and needs 19 more points to move to No. 15, tying Dan Conway (1986-89) with 1,398 career points.

- Freshman guard **Koby McEwen** leads all freshmen in the Mountain West with 15.1 points, 3.2 assists, a 1.5 assist/turnover ratio and 30.9 minutes per game.

- McEwen** has scored more points than anyone on the floor in the second half during Utah State's games in the Mountain West, logging 24 points against UNLV, 17 points against both Boise State and Air Force, and 16 points against New Mexico. Overall, McEwen is shooting 63.6 percent (21-of-33) from the floor, 70.0 percent (14-of-20) from behind the 3-point line and 88.0 percent (22-of-25) at the free throw line over the final 20 minutes.

- Utah State is second in the Mountain West with 10.5 3-point field goals made per game in league play and is the only team with three players ranked in the top 10 of the MW in 3-point field goal percentage, including freshman guard **Koby McEwen** (.583, 1st), freshman guard **Sam Merrill** (.563, 3rd) and senior wing **Jalen Moore** (.414, 8th).



Freshman guard **Koby McEwen** tied a USU freshman scoring record with 28 points against UNLV. McEwen scored 24 points in the second half, shooting 9-of-10 from the floor and 4-for-4 from 3-point range.

LOOKING AT UTAH STATE

Utah State men's basketball picked up back-to-back wins over New Mexico (79-75) and UNLV (79-63) to move to 8-7 on the year and 2-2 in the Mountain West.

The Aggies are averaging 74.1 points per game and are shooting 46.8 percent (393-of-839) from the floor, 37.2 percent (116-of-312) from behind the 3-point line and 70.6 percent (209-of-296) at the free throw line. Senior wing **Jalen Moore** leads USU in scoring, averaging 17.3 points per game, and has logged double figures in every game this season. He is followed by a pair of double-digit scorers in freshman guard **Koby McEwen** and senior guard **Shane Rector**, averaging 15.1 and 10.7 points per game, respectively.

Redshirt sophomore forward **Alexis Dargenton** leads the Aggies on the glass, averaging 5.1 rebounds per game.

Defensively, opponents are averaging 70.8 points per game against the Aggies, and shooting 41.5 percent (372-of-896) from the floor, 31.3 percent (105-of-335) from behind the 3-point line and 70.8 percent (213-of-301) at the free throw line. **Rector** leads the Aggies with 23 steals and **Dargenton** leads the team with 15 blocks.

Head coach **Tim Duryea** is in his second year at the helm, having served as an assistant the previous 14 seasons, and has compiled an overall mark of 24-22 during his tenure.

LAST TIME OUT

LOGAN, Utah – Freshman guard Koby McEwen tied a true freshman single-game scoring record with a career-high 28 points, including 24 in the second half alone, as Utah State defeated UNLV 79-63 in a Mountain West contest Saturday afternoon at the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum.

Fellow true freshman guard Sam Merrill added 14 points for the Aggies (8-7, 2-2 MW), who shot 52.6 percent from the field (30-of-57), including 61.9 percent from 3-point range (13-of-21). Senior wing Jalen Moore chipped in 14 points and has now scored in double figures in 28 straight games.

McEwen also matched redshirt sophomore wing Alexis Dargenton with a game-high seven rebounds, to go along with a team- and career-best six assists, and a career-high two blocks. Seven different Aggies recorded at least one assist as Utah State had 20 helpers on 30 baskets.

Christian Jones was the lone UNLV player to finish in double figures with 17 points. The Runnin' Rebels (8-9, 1-3) shot just 36.9 percent from the field (24-of-65) and were an icy 16.7 percent from beyond the arc (3-of-18).

SCOUTING WYOMING

Wyoming is 11-5 on the year, but 1-2 in the Mountain West and riding a two-game losing streak after defeats at UNLV (81-75) and Fresno State (85-70).

The Cowboys are averaging 77.6 points per game and shooting 42.2 percent (398-of-944) from the floor, 32.4 percent (145-of-448) from behind the 3-point line and 74.8 percent (300-of-401) at the free throw line. Wyoming has four players averaging better than double digits in sophomore guard Justin James (16.0 ppg), senior guard Jason McManamen (13.5 ppg), junior forward Hayden Dalton (12.9 ppg) and junior forward Alan Herndon (10.1 ppg). Dalton also leads the team on the glass, averaging 8.8 rebounds per contest.

Defensively, teams are averaging 72.0 points per game against the Cowboys and shooting 38.3 percent (386-of-1,009) from the floor, 29.9 percent (106-of-354) from behind the 3-point line and 74.1 percent (274-of-370) at the free throw line. James is tied for the team lead with junior guard Jeremy Lieberman with 13 steals and Herndon leads the Cowboys with 31 blocks.

Head coach Allen Edwards is in his first year after serving as an assistant coach at Wyoming for the past five years.

SERIES HISTORY AGAINST WYOMING

Wyoming owns a 48-26 advantage all-time in a series that dates back to 1925-26 and is the seventh-longest in Utah State history. Utah State snapped a three-game winning streak by the Cowboys with an 88-70 victory in the first round of the Mountain West Tournament last season.

LAST TIME AGAINST WYOMING

LAS VEGAS, Nev. – Junior guard Shane Rector scored a season-high 24 points to lead a quartet of double-digit Aggie scorers in Utah State's 88-70 opening round Mountain West Championship win against Wyoming on March 9, 2016.

Rector, whose previous scoring high was 16 points against Nevada, was 7-of-15 from the field, 3-of-6 from 3-point range and 7-of-8 at the free throw line. He also had a season-best six rebounds and played a season-high 35 minutes in just his 11th start of the season, including his first in 11 games.

Senior guard Chris Smith added 20 points for Utah State as he was 7-of-12 from the field, including 4-of-6 from behind the 3-point line, and 2-of-2 at the free throw line. Junior wing Jalen Moore added 19 points, nine rebounds and five assists as he was 7-of-15 from the field, and sophomore guard Julion Pearre came off the bench to score 14 points on 6-of-11 shooting.

Utah State finished the game shooting 48.4 percent (31-of-64) from the field, including 44.0 percent (11-of-25) from behind the 3-point line, and 83.3 percent (15-of-18) at the free throw line. Wyoming shot 37.3 percent (19-of-51) overall, as those 19 made field goals are tied for the fewest by an Aggie opponent this season. UW was also 5-of-28 (.179) shooting from 3-point range, which is a season-low shooting percentage for an Aggie opponent, but made 27-of-34 (.794) free throws, both of which are season-highs by an Aggie opponent.

LAST TIME AGAINST WYOMING IN LARAMIE

LARAMIE, Wyo. - Utah State lost an 84-65 decision at Wyoming on Feb. 6, 2016, as the Cowboys made a school-record 20 3-point shots to seal the win.

USU was led in scoring by junior wing Jalen Moore with 17 points and he was joined in double figures by senior guard Chris Smith with 13, and redshirt freshman forward Quinn Taylor with 10. As a team, Utah State shot 48.1 percent (25-of-52) from the floor, 46.7 percent (7-of-15) from behind the 3-point line and 53.3 percent (8-of-15) from the free throw line.

Wyoming was led by four players in double figures, including junior guard Jason McManamen with 20, senior guard Josh Adams with 19, and sophomore forward Alan Herndon and sophomore guard Jeremy Lieberman with 12 apiece. The Cowboys finished the game shooting 50.0 percent (28-of-56) from the floor, 52.6 percent (20-of-38) from behind the 3-point line and 80.0 percent (8-of-10) from the free throw line.

- Utah State and Wyoming will play for the 75th time on Wednesday, marking the seventh-longest series in USU history.
- Since joining the Mountain West, the difference in scoring has only been in single digits in one game. Utah State's victories have come by an average of 13.7 points per game, while Wyoming has won by an average of 15.3 points per game, including an average of 19.7 points per game over the last three games in Laramie.
- The second half has made the difference in all but one game over the last seven, as the team that has put the most points on the board over the final 20 minutes has gone on to win the game.
- Utah State has won the battle of the boards in four of the last seven games, including a 20-rebound advantage on March 5, 2014.
- Utah State has lost the battle when it comes to turnovers, committing more than Wyoming in four of the last seven games.
- Points in the paint has proven to be critical as the team that has scored more inside has won the game six of the last seven.
- Points off turnovers has also been important, as the team that has recorded more points off turnovers has won six of the last seven.
- Utah State has had at least three players score in double figures in all but two games in MW play.
- Senior wing **Jalen Moore** has scored in double figures in four straight games against Wyoming.

AGGIES PICKED SIXTH IN MOUNTAIN WEST

Utah State men's basketball was selected sixth in the annual preseason Mountain West men's basketball poll.

ALL-TIME RESULTS

Utah State has an overall record of 1,560-1,081 (.591) in its 2,641 games played.

ALL-MOUNTAIN WEST

Utah State had two players named to various preseason Mountain West awards, including freshman guard **Koby McEwen** as the Preseason Co-Freshman of the Year and senior wing **Jalen Moore** to the Preseason all-Mountain West team.

FIRST-YEAR TOURNAMENT WINS

Head coach **Tim Duryea** is the first Utah State head coach ever to win his first conference postseason game. In fact, Duryea is the first Aggie head coach to win his first-ever postseason game since **LaDell Andersen** led the Aggies to a 78-73 NCAA Tournament win against Arizona State in 1962.

BACK-TO-BACK STARTS

Utah State has started each of its seasons under head coach **Tim Duryea** with a perfect 3-0 record. Duryea is just the second coach in school history to begin each of his first two seasons as head coach with a perfect 3-0 record.

HISTORICALLY STRONG STARTS

Utah State has had strong first halves under head coach **Tim Duryea**, outscoring opponents 1,668 to 1,527 and averaging 36.3 points to 33.2 points over the course of the opening 20 minutes. USU has led at the half in eight of its 15 games this season.

WE'RE GOING TO OVERTIME

Utah State is 56-45 all-time in overtime contests. The Aggies picked up an 80-79 overtime victory at Utah Valley on Dec. 10, marking the first overtime contest for the Aggies since the 2014-15 season.

FIRST-YEAR RESULTS

Tim Duryea tied for third in Utah State history with 16 victories in his first year at the helm of the program. Duryea matched **Dutch Belnap's** win total of 16 and finished behind **Ladell Anderson** (22) and **Rod Tueller** (19).

LONG RANGE BOMBERS

Utah State has hit at least one 3-point basket in 343 consecutive games, stretching back to Dec. 16, 2006.

LONG RANGE LEADERS

Utah State is second in the Mountain West with 10.5 3-point field goals made per game in league play and is the only team with three players ranked in the top 10 of the MW in 3-point field goal percentage, including **Koby McEwen** (.583, 1st), **Sam Merrill** (.563, 3rd) and **Jalen Moore** (.414, 8th).

WINNING WITH THE TIP

Utah State is 5-1 this season when winning the opening tip.

WINNING WITH THE LONG BALL

Utah State is 8-2 this season and 20-7 under head coach **Tim Duryea** when out shooting opponents from behind the 3-point line.

WINNING OFFENSIVELY

Utah State is 8-3 this season and 22-5 under head coach **Tim Duryea** when scoring 70 or more points in a game.

WINNING DEFENSIVELY

Utah State is 5-1 this season and 15-1 under head coach **Tim Duryea** when holding opponents to less than 69 points.

WINNING AT THE HALF

Utah State is 6-2 this season and 22-6 under head coach **Tim Duryea** when leading at the half.

WINNING ON THE GLASS

Utah State is 6-4 this season and 19-7 under head coach **Tim Duryea** when outrebounding the opposition.

CONSECUTIVE WINNING SEASONS

Utah State has recorded a winning record each of the past 23 seasons, dating back to the 1992-93 campaign.

SEASONED FRESHMAN

Freshman guard **Koby McEwen** leads all freshmen in the Mountain West with 15.1 points, 3.2 assists, a 1.5 assist/turnover ratio and 30.9 minutes per game.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Utah State is calling the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum home for the 47th season, amassing a 557-134 (.811) record on its home court.

THREE YEAR LEADER

Senior wing **Jalen Moore** has led the Aggies in scoring and rebounding in each of the past two seasons, averaging 15.2 points and 6.0 rebounds as a junior, and 15.2 points and 6.7 rebounds as a sophomore, and could become just the third player in Utah State history to lead the team in scoring and rebounding for three years, joining **Greg Grant** (1982-84, 1985-86) and **Marvin Roberts** (1968-71).

ONE OF THE NATION'S BEST

Senior wing **Jalen Moore** has been named to the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year Award watch list, as announced by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Moore is one of only 20 small forwards in the nation on the watch list that was determined by a national committee comprised of top college basketball personnel.

CANCUN CHALLENGE ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

Senior wing **Jalen Moore** was named to the Cancun Challenge all-Tournament team after leading the Aggies with 18.5 points and 5.5 rebounds per game against Purdue and Texas Tech. Over the two-game stretch, Moore shot 57.7 percent (15-of-26) from the floor and 50.0 percent (5-of-10) from behind the 3-point line.

MOUNTAIN WEST LEADERS

Senior wing **Jalen Moore** is among the top-five in the Mountain West with 34.2 minutes per game (third), 17.3 points per game (fourth) and a .506 field goal percentage (fourth). Freshman guard **Koby McEwen** is among the top five with a 1.5 assist/turnover ratio, 3.2 assists per game (fourth) and a .446 3-point field goal percentage (fourth). Senior guard **Shane Rector** is fourth in the Mountain West with 1.5 steals per game.

BEST IN THE MOUNTAIN WEST

Utah State is tops in the Mountain West at the free throw line in conference play, converting 80.3 percent of its free throws (61-of-76). USU also leads the league in assists, averaging 17.3 in conference games, and 3-point field goal percentage, shooting 44.7 percent (42-of-94) from long range.

THROWING UP THE FREE THROWS

Freshman guard **Koby McEwen's** 16 free throw attempts against New Mexico were the most since **Tai Wesley** attempted 16 against Hawaii on Jan. 3, 2008. McEwen's 12 makes from the line were the most since **Chris Smith** hit 11 at Colorado State on Jan. 16, 2016.

STRONG SECOND HALVES

Freshman guard **Koby McEwen** has also been a star contributor in the second half for Utah State during conference play, scoring the most points of anyone on the floor during the final 20 minutes. McEwen logged 24 points against UNLV, 17 points against both Boise State and Air Force and 16 points against New Mexico. Overall, McEwen is shooting 63.6 percent (21-of-33) from the floor, 70.0 percent (14-of-20) from behind the 3-point line and 88.0 percent (22-of-25) at the free throw line over the final 20 minutes.

WHITE SHIRTS, BLACK NAME TAGS

Utah State has four players on its roster that served LDS Church Missions, including freshman guard **Sam Merrill** (Managua, Nicaragua), sophomore forward **Quinn Taylor** (Sao Paulo, Brazil), senior wing **Connor Garner** (Hermosillo, Mexico) and **Abel Porter** (Samara, Russia).

MOST FRESHMAN IN THE MW/STATE

Utah State's seven freshmen are the most on any roster in the Mountain West and among teams within the state of Utah.

MELTING POT

Utah State has five internationals on its roster, the most at one time in the history of Aggie basketball. The group includes **Diogo Brito** (Portugal), **Norbert Janicek** (Slovakia), **Koby McEwen** (Canada), **Alexis Dargenton** (Martinique) and **Ngor Barnaba**, who was born in Sudan, but grew up in Minnesota.

TEAM OF THE MILLENNIUM

Utah State has one of the top winning percentages since the turn of the Millennium in 2000, ranking No. 10 with a mark of .718 (403-158) going into the 2016-17 season.



North Texas, 1988
Second Year (16th Overall) (24-22)

Head coach Tim Duryea (pronounced Dur-yea) will begin his second season at the helm of Utah State men's basketball in 2016-17 after compiling the third-best start in USU history, when he led the Aggies to 16 wins in his first season in 2015-16. Prior to being promoted to the head job, Duryea was an assistant coach for the Aggies for 14 seasons. Duryea had been the longest tenured assistant coach in program history before taking over in April of 2015 and becoming the 18th head coach for USU men's basketball.

During his inaugural season, Duryea mentored junior wing Jalen Moore and senior guard Chris Smith to third-team all-Mountain West honors and became the first coach in USU history to win a conference tournament game in their first season. In addition, Utah State led the Mountain West in 3-point field goal percentage, shooting a league-best 37.0 percent (257-of-695).

In his 15 seasons at Utah State, Duryea has been part of an Aggie program that has averaged 23.1 wins per season, advanced to the NCAA Tournament six times (2003, 2005, 2006, 2009, 2010, 2011), and won five conference championships in the Big West (2003) and Western Athletic Conferences (2008, 2009, 2010, 2011), while winning four conference tournament titles in the Big West (2003, 2005) and WAC (2009, 2011).

In seven seasons leading up to his appointment as head coach, Duryea was in charge of an Aggie offense that traditionally was one of the best in the nation. The trend continued as head coach, with Utah State leading the Mountain West in 3-point field goal percentage (.370) and finishing third in the league in overall field goal percentage (.451). In 2014-15, Utah State led the Mountain West and ranked No. 14 nationally in 3-point shooting (.394), while also ranking second in the conference and No. 17 in the nation in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.38), and second in the conference and No. 19 nationally in fewest turnovers per game (10.4). Individually, USU had the best field goal shooter in the Mountain West in redshirt freshman forward David Collette, who was No. 14 in the nation at 59.1 percent (163-of-276).

In 2013-14, Utah State ranked second in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage (.406), as well as No. 12 in assists per game (15.9) and No. 19 in assist-to-ratio (1.44). During the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons, USU ranked No. 24 nationally in field goal percentage at 47.5 and 46.9 percent, respectively, while ranking No. 28 nationally in field goal percentage (.470) during the 2010-11 campaign.

During the 2009-10 season, Utah State ranked third nationally in 3-point field goal percentage (.414), ninth in overall shooting (.488) and No. 10 in free throw shooting (.758), and was the only team in the nation to rank among the top-10 in all three shooting categories. During the 2008-09 season, USU finished the year as the nation's best shooting team (.496) and ranked No. 17 in 3-point field goal percentage (.394).

Duryea spent his first seven seasons at Utah State in charge of an Aggie defense that traditionally ranked among the top in the nation in points allowed, including No. 4 in 2002 (58.1), No. 8 in 2005 (57.8) and No. 9 in 2003 (60.0).

During his time as an assistant at Utah State, the Aggies recorded a dozen 20-win seasons, including setting the school record for wins with a 30-5 mark during the 2008-09 season and a 30-4 mark during the 2010-11 campaign. USU also had 18 players earn a total of 30 all-conference honors during the past 14 years, including three WAC Players of the Year in Jaycee Carroll (2008), Gary Wilkinson (2009) and Tai Wesley (2011). Furthermore, USU had three players earn All-American citations a total of four times with Duryea on staff in Carroll (2007, 2008), Wilkinson (2009) and Wesley (2011).

Along with his on-the-court responsibilities, Duryea also oversaw academic progress as an assistant at Utah State, which resulted in 22 Aggies earning academic all-conference honors a total of 40 times over the last 14 years, while nearly 90 percent of USU's players during that time graduated.

Prior to joining the Aggies, Duryea was the head coach at Hutchinson (Kan.) Community College from 2000-01. During his two years at the helm, his teams produced a 40-25 record and back-to-back trips to the Region Six Championships.

A 1988 graduate of North Texas, Duryea began his coaching career in 1988 at Colorado State before moving on to North Texas in 1993. Duryea then went to Hutchinson (Kan.) Community College as an assistant coach for two seasons before becoming the head coach there prior to the 1999-2000 season.

Duryea played basketball at Denton (Texas) High School and Texas Pan-American before transferring to North Texas. At UNT, Duryea was a co-captain in 1988 for one of only three teams in school history to advance to the NCAA Tournament.

Duryea and his wife Angie have 21-year-old twins, Tanner (son) and Taylor (daughter), and a 14-year-old daughter (Kaylee). Tanner is a junior at Utah State, while Taylor is a sophomore volleyball player at Dixie State (Utah).

Moore has now scored 1,379 points in his career and moved to No. 16 all-time in career scoring, passing Preston Medlin (2010, 12-14) with 1,368 career points. Next on the list is Dan Conway (1986-89) with 1,389 career points. Moore passed his father on the list following the Idaho State game (11/19) and assistant coach Spencer Nelson following the game against New Orleans (12/19).

NICE FRO

Just in case you were wondering, Moore's hair has been in the making since his junior year in high school, but does get an occasional trim.

THREE-YEAR LEADER

Moore has led the Aggies in scoring and rebounding in each of the past two seasons, averaging 15.2 points and 6.0 rebounds as a junior, and 15.2 points and 6.7 rebounds as a sophomore, and could become just the third player in Utah State history to lead the team in scoring and rebounding for three years, joining Greg Grant (1982-84, 1985-86) and Marvin Roberts (1968-71).

ALL IN THE FAMILY

Father, Jimmy Moore, played basketball at USU from 1972-75, and still ranks 26th all-time in school history with 1,164 career points and 15th all-time in rebounds with 652. Jimmy Moore is currently the assistant athletics director for special projects for Utah State Athletics. Brother, Grayson, was a member of the squad last season.

DOUBLE-DIGIT SCORING STREAK

Moore has scored in double figures in each of the last 28 games and 40 of the last 41, dating back to the 2015-16 season. The streak is the longest since the 2007-08 seasons when Jaycee Carroll scored in double figures in 39 consecutive games. Moore needs three more games in double figures to tie for 10th all-time for consecutive games in double figures.
