This Weekend

Five wrestlers from the University of Wyoming will make their way to the 2017 NCAA Championships, which are set to be held on March 16-18 at the Scottrade Center in St. Louis, Mo. Branson Ashworth, Archie Colgan and Cole Mendenhall will each be making their first NCAA postseason appearance, as it will be the second trip each for Bryce Meredith and Drew Templeman. It will mark the 24th time that Wyoming will send at least five wrestlers to the national tournament. UW finished 18th at last year's NCAA Championships as Meredith, Templeman and Tanner Harms represented the Brown and Gold at Madison Square Garden.

Last Year at the NCAA Championships

Bryce Meredith's title run fell just short in the NCAA Championship finals last season. Meredith fell to Oklahoma State's Dean Heil in Madison Square Garden in New York City. He was the first Cowboy to wrestle in the finals since Reese Andy in 1996. The Cowboys finished 18th in the team standings with 24.5 points. It was the 18th time in school history the Cowboys have finished in the Top-25 at the NCAA Championships and the Pokes' highest finish as well as the third top-25 finish under head coach Mark Branch. It was also the best team finish for UW since finishing 15th in 1996.

Big 12 Championships Wrap Up

Led by Bryce Meredith's runner-up finish at 141-pounds, the University of Wyoming wrestling team took fifth place at the 2017 Big 12 Championship. Cole Mendenhall and Drew Templeman each claimed a third place finish at their respective weights, while Branson Ashworth and Archie Colgan took fifth at 165 and 157, respectively.

Wyoming in the Rankings

The Pokes have five wrestlers within the national rankings. UW is led by All-American Bryce Meredith, who is ranked No. 8 by several organizations. Drew Templeman (No. 13) at 125-pounds, Branson Ashworth (No. 16), Archie Colgan (No. 19) and Cole Mendenhall (No. 20) are also all ranked in the top-20 of their respective weights in the InterMat Individual rankings.

Final NCAA Coaches' Panel Rankings & RPI

The five Cowboy wrestlers that were ranked in the first three Coaches' Panel Rankings all remain in the final rankings. Meredith is the highest ranked Poke coming in at eighth at 141 pounds. Templeman is 12th at 125 pounds, while redshirt sophomore Branson Ashworth sits 14th at 165 pounds. Archie Colgan (157) is 15th while Cole Mendenhall (149) is 18th in their respective weights. Four Cowboys were ranked in the release of the final RPI rankings on Thursday. Colgan is 13th at 157 to lead UW as Meredith is 14th at 141 pounds. Ashworth is 15th at 165 pounds with Mendenhall 20th at 149 for the Brown and Gold.

NCAA Championships Rundown

125 Pounds

Senior **Drew Templeman** (19-7) will enter his second and final NCAA tournament after a third-place finish at the Big 12 Championship last weekend and will face Conor Youtsey of Michigan. Templeman went 1-2 at last year's Big Dance in New York. Youtsey is a two-time All-American and rejoined the Wolverine wrestling program in January. The fifth-year senior is 6-6 on the season and finished in fifth-place at this year's Big Ten conference tournament.

141 Pounds

Junior **Bryce Meredith** (28-6) heads to his second NCAA Wrestling Championships as he earned the No. 10 seed at 141-pounds. The Cheyenne native took second at the Big 12 Championships after a 10-7 decision loss to defending national champion, Dean Heil of Oklahoma State. The junior will face Mike Longo (19-8) from Oklahoma in the opening round. Longo secured a third-place finish in Tulsa last weekend. Meredith has won both matches between the two wrestlers this season, including a pin in Norman on Feb. 10. Meredith was placed as the No. 14 seed a year ago before going 4-1 at the tournament and earning All-American honors with a runner-up finish.

149 Pounds

After a third-place finish at the Big 12 tournament, senior **Cole Mendenhall** will enter the national tournament as the lone unseeded Cowboy. Mendenhall (29-8) will man the 149-pound weight class for UW and will face No. 2 Anthony Collica (20-2) of Oklahoma State in the opening round. Collica, a 2016 All-American, earned his fourth career Big 12 Championship title last weekend in Tulsa.

157 Pounds

Junior **Archie Colgan** (34-8) was selected as an at-large bid for the tournament and was then awarded the No. 15 seed at 157-pounds. Colgan earned a fifth-place finish at Big 12s and will see Ediboro's Chase Delande (21-16) to open Nationals. Delane will be making his first appearance to the Big Dance after he earned second place at the EWL Championships this past weekend.

165 Pounds

Redshirt sophomore **Branson Ashworth** is the youngest of the Cowboys that will be making the trip. He is seeded at No. 14 for the tournament after a fifth-place finish at the Big 12 tournament. He holds a 35-7 overall record for the Brown and Gold this season and will face Brian Hamann of North Carolina State in the opening round on Thursday. Hamann (20-10) will be also making his first trip to Nationals. He fell in the ACC Championship en route to the automatic bid.

Familiar Sight

Drew Templeman qualified for his second NCAA Championship after a third-place finish at the Big 12 Championships. It marks the ninth-straight season that 125 pound wrestler has competed at the NCAA Championship. Tyler Cox was a staple at the event the three seasons before Templeman. Since a change in the weight class structure in 1999 UW has had a wrestler wrestle at the 125-weight class 11 times.

Wyoming Represent

Bryce Meredith, a native of Cheyenne, continues the streak of a Wyoming native qualifying for the NCAA Championships making it five-straight seasons. Tyler Cox made three-straight trips to the NCAA Championships from 2013-15.

306 at Nationals

The Cowboys will now have 306 total wrestlers that have competed at the NCAA Championships. UW has sent a wrestler to the NCAA Championship for 42 straight seasons dating back to 1974.

Big 12 Championships in Review

Led by Bryce Meredith's runner-up finish at 141-pounds, the University of Wyoming wrestling team took fifth place at the 2017 Big 12 Championship in Tulsa, Okla. In the two years of being a member of the Big 12 conference, Meredith became Wyoming's second finalist at the tournament, but fell to top-ranked Dean Heil of Oklahoma State.

Meredith, Drew Templeman, Cole Mendenhall and Branson Ashworth all secured their spots for the NCAA Championship in St. Louis on March 16-18.

Oklahoma State had eight total individual champions and took home first place with 176.5 points. It was OSU's fifth-straight championship title. Oklahoma came in second (93.5) with South Dakota State (90.5) and North Dakota State (82.5) following. UW earned 71.5 points during the two-day tournament.

"It was definitely nice to see a few of our guys place this weekend," UW head coach Mark Branch said. "I thought a couple of our guys came out a little conservative this morning, but were able to turn it up a notch when they needed to. Bryce (Meredith) has seen Dean Heil a few times now and each time I think it gets to be a better match. We have talked with him protecting his legs, but we knew it would be a tough one. I think he did some good things during the match and I hope these two get a rematch, depending on how the seeding works out. Next stop is the NCAA Tournament and we all look forward to that."

In the 141-pound final, Meredith gave up two first period takedowns and countered with two escapes. Meredith started the second period on bottom and scored another escape to close Heil's lead to one, 4-3. The junior recorded a reversal in the final period before another escape. Heil took the fourth matchup between the two by a score of 10-7.

Mendenhall and Templeman each claimed a third place finish during Sunday's morning session of the Big 12 Championship. Mendenhall pinned Alex Kocer of South Dakota State en route to qualifying for his first NCAA Tournament. Templeman came away with a 4-3 decision over Christian Moody in the third-place bout. It will mark his second-consecutive trip to Nationals.

Templeman began the day with a solid 5-1 decision over Kyle Larsen of Iowa State. A takedown early against Moody set the tone in the match. Templeman also scored two escape points and was awarded a stalling point.

Mendenhall opened the second day of the tournament with an impressive major of Jerry McGinty in the consolation semifinal. Three takedowns plus a two-point nearfall was clearly more than enough for Mendenhall to move to the third-place match. The senior faced Alex Kocer in his final match of the tournament. His third-place outcome came via a pin of Kocer in the first period.

Archie Colgan faced Oklahoma's Clark Glass in the consolation semifinal at 157. The Sooner came away with a 2-0 decision win over Colgan. Colgan then redeemed himself in the fifth-place match. He handed Colton DiBlasi a 15-0 tech fall to close out the championship in fifth place at 157 for the Brown and Gold.

Like Colgan, Ashworth brought home a fifth-place finish for UW. With the place, he secured his first trip to the NCAA Tournament. Both of his matches this morning came down to the last few seconds. Ashworth came out on top in the fifth-place match against Andrew Fogarty of NDSU. Riding time was in favor of Ashworth when the match ended. In his first bout of the day, Luke Silverberg won a 4-3 decision to advance past the redshirt sophomore.

Kyle Pope took UW's third fifth-place finish of the Big 12 Championship on Sunday. Both of his matches were similar to Ashworth's regarding score. Pope dropped the consolation semifinal match early this morning before earning a 4-3 decision of Kimball Bastian for fifth-place.

Senior Brandon Tribble fought hard once again but closed out his career wearing the Brown and Gold on Sunday morning. In the consolation semifinal, Tribble fell 6-1 to Ben Tynan before falling to Quean Smith in the fifth-place match.



2016 NCAA Championships in Review

Bryce Meredith's title run fell just short at the NCAA Championship finals match at 141 pounds. Meredith fell to Oklahoma State's Dean Heil in Madison Square Garden in New York City. He was the first Cowboy to wrestle in the finals since Reese Andy in 1996.

The Cowboys finished 18th in the team standings with 24.5 points. It is the 18th time in school history the Cowboys have finished in the Top-25 at the NCAA Championship. It was the Pokes' highest finish as well as the third top-25 finish under head coach Mark Branch. It was the best team finish for UW since finishing 15th in 1996.

"To be one of twenty guys to compete for a national title is something very special," UW head coach Mark Branch said. "It stings and is a challenge to really look at the bigger picture right now. But as a team it is all about scoring points and it was a great team effort to be in the top-20 is something to be proud of. It gives us a lot of motivation to build on that for the future."

Meredith fell to the top-seeded Heil by decision 3-2. In a match between Big 12 Foes, Heil scored the only takedown of the match in the first period. Meredith earned a pair of escapes and Heil added an escape to make the match 3-2 late in the third period. Meredith nearly picked up a fall in the third, but fell just short earning runner-up honors.

"To go out there and compete at the highest level is special and he showed what he is capable of," Branch said. "I told him he can beat anyone in the country and it's exciting to see him use this experience."

Meredith finished the season with a 29-5 record becoming the 32nd All-American selection in Cowboy history and the ninth under head coach Mark Branch. He is also the eighth All-American from the state of Wyoming and the third equality state native to earn a spot in the finals. His match tonight marked the eighth time in school history that a UW wrestler has wrestled in the finals.

2016-17: After a few weeks at 133 for the Brown and Gold, Templeman moved abck to 125 and has cruised to a 19-7 record heading to NAAs. Most recently, the senior brought home a third-place finish at Big 12s and will be attending his second-career national tournament.

2015-16: Templeman started the season moving from 133 pounds to 125 pounds. He finished fourth at the Big 12 Championship to earn his first berth for the NCAA Championship where he had a decision (9-7) of Shakur Laney of Ohio. Templeman opened the season with five-straight wins. He won the Reno Tournament of Champions, including a win over No. 14 Josh Rodriguez of North Dakota State. He finished the season with a 19-10 record with one fall.

2014-15: Templeman had a strong sophomore campaign for the Pokes. He finished the season with a 19-11 overall record going 10-5 in duals. He recorded one pin and technical fall and added three major decisions. He was a Third Team All-WWC selection winning his final two matches of the NCAA West Regional/WWC Championship. Recorded a six match winning streak during the season, which including going 3-0 at the Journeyman/ASICS Northeast Duals.

2013-14: Despite wrestling for much of the fall semester, Templeman struggled with an arm injury sustained early in the year. He saw action in three duals, helping UW defeat Boise State with a 3-2 decision in his first career dual. He competed versus Minnesota and in the Las Vegas Invitational, but was shut down after the Oklahoma State dual for the remainder of the year. He finished 4-6 and 1-2 in duals.

2012-13: Wrestling unattached as a redshirt, Templeman began the season on a 16-0 tear with three tournament crowns. With a final 25-5 mark, he finished tied for fourth on the team in total wins and tied for first with 10 major decisions. Twelve of his wins came via bonus points. He was first in the Cowboy, Northwest, UNK Holiday Inn and Utah Valley Opens, and was sixth in the Reno Tournament of Champions. He finished his season with a 2-2 showing in the National Collegiate Open, a tournament for some of the nation's top redshirts and wrestlers not competing in their school's NCAA qualifier.

High School: Templeman dominated during his high school wrestling career, and came away with four-straight Washington state titles. He was named Athlete of the Year for Pierce County in 2012, shortly after he completed his four-peat. Orting won the team wrestling title in Templeman's senior season. He earned Athlete of the Month honors each season.

Personal: Templeman was born in Puyallup, Wash., and is the son of Steve and Joanne Templeman. He has one sibling, Bryce. Templeman also received interest from Oregon State and Arizona State.

2016-17: After a runner-up finish at last year's NCAAs, Meredith will make his way back to the Big Dance for the second time in his career. The All-American rides a second-place finish at the Big 12 Championships into St. Louis for Wyoming. Meredith has defeated his first round opponent, Mike Longo of Oklahoma, twice already this season, including a pin in Norman, Okla., on Feb. 10.

2015-16: Meredith finished the season with a 29-5 record becoming the 32nd All-American selection in Cowboy history and the ninth under head coach Mark Branch. He also became the eighth All-American from the state of Wyoming and the third equality state native to earn a spot in the finals. Meredith became the first NCAA finalist for UW since Reese Andy in 1996, as he eventually fell to the top-seeded Dean Heil of Oklahoma State by decision, 3-2. He opened the championships with a major decision over Robbie Mathers of Arizona State and then upset former teammate and third-ranked Kevin Jack of North Carolina State. On the second day of the NCAA Championships, he had a decision each over No. 6 Micah Jordan of Ohio State and Stanford's No. 2 Joey McKenna to move on to the finals. Meredith was named the Big 12 Wrestler of the Week after his major decision over Anthony Abidin of Nebraska on Nov. 21. He stayed ranked the rest of the season. Additionally, he won the Reno Tournament of Champions with a perfect 5-0 record.

Before UW: Wrestled at North Carolina State for one season. He was the Wolfpack's starter at 133 pounds. He went 15-7 during his freshman season going 14-5 in duals. He recorded four pins and four major decisions on the season.

High School: Meredith is a graduate of Central High School in Cheyenne. He was a four-time state champion. He was also a four-time NHSCA All-American. During his high school career he recorded a record of 123-8. Meredith was ranked as a top-100 recruit by intermatwrestle.com, d1wrestling.net and flowrestling.org.

2016-17: Mendenhall will be making his first trip to Nationals after he claimed fifth-place at the Big 12 Championships. The senior went 3-1 at last weekend's tournament in Tulsa. Mendenhall will face the No. 2 seed Anthony Collica of Oklahoma State in the opening round.

2015-16: Mendenhall joined the Cowboy lineup halfway through the season, moving from 141 pounds to 149 pounds. He went 2-2 at the Big 12 Championships, just missed out on qualifying for the NCAA Championship and ended the season with a 17-9 overall record. He also went 9-5 against Big 12 opponents and had five pins and five major decisions during his junior campaign.

2014-15: Mendenhall was a key member of the Cowboys in his sophomore season. He finished the season with a 16-16 overall record and finished the season with one pin. Mendenhall was named Third Team All-WWC after going 2-1 at the NCAA West Regional/WWC Championship. He earned a second place finish at the Cowboy open falling to No. 17 Anthony Abidin of Nebraska in the finals. He sported a six match winning streak, which included going 3-0 at the Journeyman/ASICS Northeast Duals.

2013-14: Mendenhall seized the starting role at 141 pounds and kept the spot throughout the season with some great performances. The aggressive youngster began his season 9-0 with two tournament titles, in the Cowboy and Northwest Opens. He helped UW win its opening dual versus Boise State with an 8-6 decision in sudden victory. After a rough patch, he turned things around with a 4-2 showing in the always-tough Reno Tournament of Champions. Down the home stretch, Mendenhall was 5-0 to end the regular season, including three falls. For the year, he was 21-10 (seventh on UW) with 11 falls to lead all starters. He posted two major decisions for 13 bonus-point wins. He went 7-5 in duals and was 5-2 versus conference opponents. In the West Regional, he went 1-1, dropping a heartbreaker in the title match, 8-7. He just missed out on qualifying for the NCAA Championships. In the freestyle portion of his season, he went 2-2 at 66 kilograms (145.5 pounds) in the ASICS Junior National Championships.

2012-13: Redshirting in his first season with UW, Mendenhall showed his talent off early and often. He ranked in the top five in several categories for the season on the team, including No. 4 in wins (25), No. 2 in pins (10) and No. 2 in technical falls (3). He wrestled in six open tournaments, winning five of them and placing third in the other. He tallied a mark of 25-1, with 14 bonus-point wins. The champion of the Cowboy Open, UNK Holiday Inn Open, Battle of the Rockies, the UNK Loper Open and the Utah Valley Open, his lone loss came in an 8-7 decision in the Northwest Open. He won his last 18 bouts of the year in folkstyle competition. Mendenhall was seventh at FILA Junior Nationals in April 2013, going 3-2 at 63 kilograms (138.75 pounds).

High School: Mendenhall joined some exclusive company after his senior year, when he became a four-time Montana state champion. He compiled a 130-7 career record, for a winning percentage of 95 percent. In his senior season, he finished second at Senior Nationals to earn All-America honors.

2016-17: Colgan went 2-2 and brought home fifth-place at the Big 12 Championships. He was then selected for an at-large bid to Nationals, before receiving the No. 15 seed at 157. Colgan is the first wrestler for UW at 157 in the national tournament since Andy McCulley in 2013.

2015-16: Colgan had another impressive season for the Pokes. He finished the season with a 20-10 record with a 9-3 dual record. He was 13-4 against Big 12 opponents during his sophomore campaign. Colgan came away victorious with a decision against #12 Dylan Cottrell of West Virginia in the Southern Scuffle. He opened the Big 12 Championship with a major against Logan Breitenbach of Iowa State and also won the fifth-place match with a first period pin against Breitenbach to close out the championships.

2014-15: Colgan had a strong redshirt freshman season with the Cowboys on his way to earning Second Team All-WWC honors. He finished the season with a 22-12 overall record going 8-6 in duals. He picked up three pins on the season to go along with three technical falls and two major decisions. He won the Northwest Open to open the season and finished second at the Cowboy Open falling to the nation's second ranked wrestler James Green of Nebraska. He faced the nation's second ranked and top ranked wrestlers in back-to-back matches.

2013-14: An aggressive, attacking style served Colgan well in his redshirt season. In seven open tournaments, he finished third or better, including first in the Viking-Warrior Open and the U.S. Western National Open to cap off his season at 157 pounds. He was 26-5 overall (fifth on UW) and led the squad with seven technical falls. He finished his season winning 10 of 11 bouts, and had three falls and four major decisions for the year. Other notable finishes included second at the Cowboy Open and runner-up honors at the UNC Old Chicago Open. Capping off his season at the ASICS Junior National Championships in April, Colgan went 2-2 in the 70-kilogram (154.25 pounds) class.

High School: Colgan finished his high school career off with a Colorado state title after placing third as a sophomore and junior. He concluded his senior season at Pomona High with a 39-4 record and the state 160-pound crown. He finished third at state as a junior at 152 pounds, and was third as a sophomore at 140 pounds. Colgan was the 2012 Junior National folkstyle runner-up at 152 pounds and won the Colorado State freestyle crown at 152 pounds in 2011. He placed fifth at the 2013 NHSCA Senior Nationals to become an All-American.

Personal: Born in Denver, Colo., he is the son of Ed and Josie Colgan. He has two siblings, Jasmine and Eamonn. He has not decided on a major at UW.




