

## 2017 Spring Practice Begins for Wyoming Cowboys on March 21 Media Luncheon at Noon Will Kick Off Spring Practice

**Laramie, Wyo. (March 16, 2017)** -- Wyoming Cowboy Football will begin its on-field preparation for the 2017 season on Tuesday, March 21. The first day of Spring Practice will kick off with a media luncheon at Noon in the Wildcatter Stadium Club and Suites at War Memorial Stadium. A late afternoon practice will conclude the first day.

The Cowboys are coming off one of their most successful seasons in recent history. UW hosted the 2016 Mountain West Championship Game, as winners of the Mountain Division, and earned a bid to the San Diego County Credit Union Poinsettia Bowl. The Pokes defeated two Top 25 ranked teams along the way, earned the National Team of the Week honors from the Football Writers Association of America (FWAA) for one of those Top 25 wins and accomplished all that against the 19th most difficult schedule in the country among all 128 Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) teams and the second most difficult schedule among all Group of Five schools.

#### **Wyoming Football Focused on Taking Another Step Forward**

Wyoming head coach **Craig Bohl** returns for his fourth season as the Cowboy head coach. The 2016 Mountain West Conference Coach of the Year led the Cowboys to one of the biggest turnarounds in college football in 2016, but after the conclusion of the 2016 season his attention quickly turned to what lies ahead for Wyoming Football.

"Taking another step forward as a football program is our focus entering this spring," said Bohl. "Last year, we were competitive within our conference, but we need to continue to take steps to improve.

"There are certain areas of our football team that we feel pretty good about. Obviously, the quarterback position is more entrenched than it has been, and the safety and cornerback spots return a lot of experienced players.

- "I think we have some young, emerging wide receivers, who we are really excited about.
- "I believe we'll be stronger at the defensive line position. We have a lot more depth there.
- "We have a returning place-kicker in place, and it will be important to continue to improve there.
- "We have a lot of returning offensive linemen, but we will have to find a center and we have a couple candidates in our existing group that we may look to move into that position."

#### Outreach Game in Casper on April 8 to be Part of 2017 Spring Football Schedule

Bohl said that spring practice will take a similar structure as the past three years, but there will be some aspects of practices that will have to take into account depth at certain positions due to offseason rehabilitation of injuries.

"Typically in spring our goals are: one, to install our systems on offense, defense and the kicking game; the next goal is to evaluate personnel; and the third one is to experiment a little bit with different schemes," said Bohl.

"It will be similar, but we will be sensitive to our depth and our injury situation. We will practice Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays and later in spring we plan to have a couple live scrimmages."

The Cowboys are allowed 15 spring practices, which will be spread over five weeks. One of the five Saturday practices will be a practice open to fans and media to be held at Natrona County High School in Casper, Wyo., on April 8 at 1 p.m. -- weather permitting. The other open practice will be the Spring Game on Saturday, April 22 at 2 p.m. in War Memorial Stadium.

#### New Coaches Join Wyoming's Defensive Coaching Staff

Another important part of 2017 Spring Practice will be the introduction of two new defensive coaches into the Wyoming Football program.

"This spring will also be an opportunity for our defense to work with a new defensive coordinator and new safeties coach and give our players the chance to get accustomed to their two new coaches."

Wyoming's new defensive coordinator is **Scottie Hazelton**, who comes to Wyoming from the Jacksonville Jaguars of the NFL where he coached the linebackers. While he is new to the Wyoming Football program, he is not new to Bohl and his coaching staff. Hazelton was part of Bohl's very successful staff at North Dakota State for five seasons from 2007-11. Hazelton was the defensive line coach his first three seasons and served as the defensive coordinator his final two years, culminating with the 2011 FCS National Championship his final season at NDSU.

"It was critical for us to bring in Scottie (Hazelton)," said Bohl. "We've been running a lot of the same systems for years. Scottie and I worked together several years, and he was really the architect for our championship defenses at North Dakota State. It's good to have him back on our staff. His leadership with our defense will be really important. He's a proven quantity."

The Cowboys' new safeties coach is **Jake Dickert**. He served as the safeties coach and co-special teams coordinator at South Dakota State in 2016. Dickert also is a familiar face to Bohl and his staff. He joined the North Dakota State coaching staff in 2008 as a defensive graduate assistant on Bohl's staff. In 2009 and 2010, he was elevated to serve as safeties coach for the Bison. The 2010 NDSU team advanced to the FCS National Quarterfinals.

#### Fifteen Starters and 51 Letterwinners Return for Wyoming in 2017

The 2017 Cowboy roster returns 15 starters and 51 letterwinners. Key among them are 2016 First Team All-Mountain West Conference free safety **Andrew Wingard**, Second Team All-MW quarterback **Josh Allen** and Mountain West Freshman of the Year, linebacker **Logan Wilson**. Wingard also was one of 16 national semifinalists for the 2016 Jim Thorpe Award, honoring the nation's best defensive back. Allen was named a Manning Award Star of the Week as a sophomore, and was twice named the Mountain West Offensive Player of the Week. Wilson was named a First Team Freshman All-American by both the Football Writers Association of America (FWAA) and by USA Today Sports.

Wyoming will return six starters on offense and 24 offensive lettermen. In addition to starting quarterback Allen, he will be joined in the backfield by senior fullback **Drew Van Maanen**. Four of the offensive line spots return starters, including left tackle **Zach Wallace**, left guard **Gavin Rush**, right guard **Kaden Jackson** and two players who each started seven games at right tackle. **Ryan Cummings** started the first seven games of the 2016 season before suffering a season-ending injury. **Brinkley Jolly** took over and started the final seven games of the season. The one hole on the O-Line that must be filled is a big one. Center **Chase Roullier** has graduated. Roullier was a First Team All-MW selection as a senior and earned Second Team All-America honors from USA Today Sports. Other key losses include: the departure of Wyoming's career rushing leader **Brian Hill**, who earned First Team All-Mountain West honors and was a Third Team All-America selection by College Sports Madness; the loss of First Team All-MW tight end **Jacob Hollister**; and the loss of Second Team All-MW wide receiver **Tanner Gentry** and fellow senior receiver **Jake Maulhardt**.

Defensively, eight starters and 26 lettermen return. Joining Wingard at safety is fellow two-year starter **Marcus Epps**. Starting cornerbacks **Rico Gafford** and **Antonio Hull** also return. Wilson, who starred at weakside linebacker as a freshman in 2016, is going to be given a look at middle linebacker this spring. On the defensive line, **Kevin Prosser** and **Josiah Hall** return at defensive end. In addition, **Carl Granderson** is back after missing the final eight games of his sophomore season following season-ending knee surgery. Inside, **Conner Cain** returns after starting a combination of 12 games at defensive tackle and nose tackle in 2016. He is joined in the middle by junior **Sidney Malauulu** and sophomore **Youhanna Ghaifan**.

Wyoming's one key returning starter on special teams is sophomore place-kicker **Cooper Rothe**, who had a strong true freshman season a year ago. Key losses are four-year starters **Ethan Wood** at punter and **Brendan Turelli** at long snapper.

The first 30 minutes of practices will be open to media. The practice in Casper on Saturday, April 8 and the Spring Game on Saturday, April 22 will both be open to both media and the general public.

# Position-by-Position Breakdowns <u>Defense</u>

Andrew Wingard
Junior Free Safety
2016 First Team All-Mountain West
2016 Semifinalist for Jim Thorpe Award

### **Secondary**

The past two years, the Wyoming secondary has been a group filled with young talent. In 2017, the secondary will be among the most veteran groups for the Cowboys. The entire secondary returns led by junior safeties **Andrew Wingard** and **Marcus Epps**, who enter their third consecutive season starting beside one another. Senior safety **Jalen Ortiz** is a leading candidate to take over as Wyoming's nickel back in 2017. Providing depth are juniors **Chavez Pownell Jr.** and **Anthony Makransky**. Sophomore **Alijah Halliburton** was a regular on special teams as a true freshman in 2016, and redshirt freshman **Josh Boyd** is another talented young player.

The cornerback position likewise is filled with returning veterans. Junior **Antonio Hull** and seniors **Rico Gafford** and **Robert Priester** all have extensive experience as starters. Sophomores **Tyler Hall** and **Davion Freeman** were important special teams performers a year ago, and redshirt freshman **Braden Smith** could also factor into the mix at cornerback.

"At the cornerback position, I think we have a lot of depth there," said Bohl. "Between Antonio (Hull), Robert (Priester) and Rico (Gafford) we have three experienced players who have all started for us. Tyler Hall played a little bit as a true freshman, and Davion Freeman is another young player who has played for us. That is a

pretty seasoned group. There will be some intense competition to see which two or three rise to the top.

"The safety position -- we are pretty well entrenched with Marcus Epps and Andrew Wingard. Jalen Ortiz we're looking at spending a lot of time as our nickel back.

#### **Linebackers**

Gone from the linebacking corps are 2016 senior stalwarts **Lucas Wacha** and **D.J. May**, but 2016 Freshman All-American and Mountain West Freshman of the Year **Logan Wilson** does return. Wilson is going to experiment at a new position in the spring of 2017, moving from his weakside linebacking spot to the middle linebacker position previously held by Wacha. Other returners to the linebacking corps include senior **Tim Kamana**, junior **Adam Pilapil**, sophomores **Cassh Maluia** and **Ben Wisdorf** along with a host of young players.

"We're exploring having Logan Wilson move to our MIKE linebacker (middle linebacker), and in the Tampa-2 that is a critical position," said Bohl. "A young player who played well in our bowl game was Cassh Maluia. Cassh is going to go to the weakside linebacker spot. We'll be taking a look at a variety of guys at our SAM (strongside) linebacker in the spring."

**Defensive Line** 

The defensive line will return an exciting blend of experience and youth in 2017. The only significant loss from last year was 2016 senior Chase Appleby at nose tackle, but a total of eight different defensive linemen who saw extensive playing time a year ago return. Juniors Conner Cain and Sidney Malauulu and sophomore Youhanna Ghaifan all return at the nose tackle and defensive tackles positions. At defensive end, junior **Kevin Prosser** returns after leading the Cowboys in both sacks (6.5) and tackles for loss (11.0) in 2016. Fellow junior defensive end Carl Granderson was having an outstanding season a year ago before his season came to an end in week six when he suffered a knee injury against Air Force. He is expected to be fully recovered by next fall, but won't participate in 2017 spring practice. Sophomore **Josiah Hall** started 11 of 14 games as a redshirt freshman last season. Senior **Nela Lolohea** also returns after playing in all 14 games and starting one in his first season at Wyoming after transferring from El Camino Community College in California. Sophomore defensive end Shiloh Windsor rounds out the group of eight returning D-Linemen with playing experience. Windsor's redshirt was pulled the week following Granderson's injury. Windsor played in seven of the final eight games of his true freshman season and started one game against San Diego State in the regular-

season meeting between the two teams.

"Our defensive ends are a group that has a number of experienced players returning," said Bohl. "Carl Granderson is not going to be in position to go through contact this spring, but between Josiah Hall, Kevin Prosser and Shiloh Windsor, who played some as a true freshman, along with Nela Lolohea we have some good experience returning there.

"At our defensive tackle positions, we have a lot of experience there too, with Conner Cain and Youhanna Ghaifan. Youhanna really played well against BYU in the bowl game. Sid Malauulu is another experienced interior lineman returning."

## **Offense**

#### Quarterbacks

For the first time in the four seasons Bohl and his staff have been at Wyoming the Cowboys have a returning starter at quarterback. Junior **Josh Allen** burst on the college football scene in 2017. His dynamic play earned him Second Team All-Mountain West honors and attracted attention from NFL scouts, some of who thought he might enter the NFL Draft early this year. Allen should be one of the top returning QBs in the nation in 2017. He led the MW and ranked 20th in the nation in passing touchdowns (28) a year ago. He led the conference and ranked No. 16 in the NCAA in points responsible for, and he led the country and ranked No. 6 in the nation in passing yards per completion. Fellow junior **Nick Smith** also returns for the Cowboys, giving the Pokes an experienced tandem to lead the Wyoming offense.

"Josh (Allen) and Nick (Smith) have played a lot of football for us the past two years," said Bohl. "It is a huge positive to have that kind of experience back at the quarterback position."

#### **Running Backs and Fullbacks**

Wyoming's all-time leading rusher **Brian Hill** decided to forego his senior season and declare for the 2017 NFL Draft. The Third Team All-American ended his career with the Wyoming records for career rushing yards (4,287) and single-season rushing yards (1,860). With Hill's departure, there is a group of returning players who will compete for playing time at running back. Junior **Nico Evans**, sophomores **Kellen Overstreet** and **Milo Hall** and redshirt freshman **Mike Green II** are the leading candidates entering spring practice.

Senior **Drew Van Maanen** returns for his third year starting at fullback for the Cowboys. Junior **Matt List** also returns, and sophomore **Jaylon Watson** has moved to fullback from defensive end.

"Kellen Överstreet is a young man who redshirted last year," said Bohl. "Milo Hall has been working hard there, as has Nico Evans and a redshirt freshman in Mike Green. We have some players there. It is just a matter of which guys are going to rise to the top.

"At the fullback position, we have good experience with our returning starter Drew Van Maanen back. Jaylon Watson will be moving over to the fullback position this spring. Matt List is another returning fullback, so we have three guys there who have been in our system for several years.

#### Wide Receivers

An explosive group of young receivers will get their opportunity to shine this season after playing in the shadow of seniors **Tanner Gentry** and **Jake Maulhardt** last year. The young group includes junior **James Price** and sophomores **C.J. Johnson**, **Austin Conway** and **John Okwoli**. Johnson had an outstanding redshirt freshman season in 2016, catching 21 passes for 304 yards and scoring three touchdowns, including the game-winning touchdown versus San Diego State. Conway had 11 receptions for 103 yards on the year, and Price caught six passes for 75 yards. Okwoli played primarily on special teams as a true freshman, but came to Wyoming as a highly-regarded recruit.

"The wide receiver position has some really talented players, but they have not played significant reps in game situations," said Bohl. "Certainly, C.J. (Johnson) finished off the year on a high note, as did James Price. Austin Conway did a lot of good things as a return specialist, and we also utilized him some in both the passing game and the run game. He certainly was a playmaker for us last year. John Okwoli contributed last year on special teams as a true freshman, and he is another guy in the mix there. We feel like we have really good ability at that position. It is just a matter of them taking the next step in their careers."

#### **Tight Ends**

The Wyoming tight-end position is similar to the wide receiver group in that there is a group of talented players returning who should now get their opportunity to shine in the Cowboy offense. While First Team All-Mountain West tight end **Jacob Hollister** is gone, juniors **Tyree Mayfield**, **Josh Harshman** and **Austin Fort** all return. Mayfield and Harshman have played in the last 26 and 25 games, respectively, for the Cowboys. Mayfield has 10 career starts to his credit and Harshman two. Fort played in 13 of 14 games for UW last season, primarily on special teams, but made a good transition from quarterback to tight end last season.

"Our tight ends are another pretty deep position for us," said Bohl. "Tyree Mayfield and Josh Harshman have both played significant roles the past two seasons for us. Austin Fort is another guy at tight end who we believe can be a contributor. The fourth guy is redshirt freshman Sam Maughan. We've gone from having virtually no tight ends in our program when we first got here, to developing some pretty good depth. That is part of developing a program. Now going into our fourth year, our football team is starting to look more like what we want it to be."

#### **Offensive Line**

Up front, the Cowboys return starters at four of the five offensive line spots. Left tackle is expected to once again be manned by junior **Zach Wallace**. Junior **Kaden Jackson** returns after starting at right guard in 2016. The right tackle position has two players returning who each started seven games last season. Senior **Ryan Cummings** started the first seven games of 2016 before suffering a season-ending foot injury. Junior **Brinkley Jolly** stepped in and started the final seven games a year ago. Sophomore **Gavin Rush** started all 14 games at left guard as a true freshman in 2016. He is the leading candidate to take over the center spot left vacant by 2016 Second Team All-American **Chase Roullier**, who graduated last December.

"On the offensive line, we have a lot of experience back," said Bohl. "We're still probably a player or two short in terms of developing the kind of depth we want, but between Kaden Jackson, Gavin Rush and Zach Wallace we have three returning starters who will be available during spring. Two other returning starters in Brinkley Jolly and Ryan Cummings will not be available for spring practice as they continue to rehab from injuries. But we have a strong core group of experience returning for next year."

#### **Special Teams**

A year ago, Wyoming entered the season without a proven place-kicker. That responsibility was placed on true freshman **Cooper Rothe**, who concluded his first year of college football hitting 64 of 64 extra points and 13 of 20 field goals. Rothe converted 10 of 12 field goals inside the 40-yard line. For a true freshman, Rothe handled the transition to college kicking well. Improving his range beyond 40 yards and continuing to improve his consistency will be goals for his sophomore season.

Two valuable senior specialists completed their eligibility last season. Punter **Ethan Wood** and long snapper **Brendan Turelli** ended their Wyoming careers playing 50 straight games at their respective positions. At punter, sophomore quarterback **Nick Szpor**, who also served as the holder for the Cowboys last season, will handle punting duties throughout spring practice. He will be joined in the fall by freshman signee **Tim Zaleski**. Competition for the starting long-snapping duties will likely be between graduate transfer **Kolton Donovan** and redshirt freshman **Seth Cottengim**.

"Cooper Rothe returns as our place-kicker," said Bohl. "Cooper got his feet wet last year. He has good ability. I think his leg will continue to get stronger. He needs to continue to improve his accuracy, and I believe he will. Cooper is a competitive guy. He understands what it's like to go out there and compete.

"At punter, we're going to work with Nick Szpor, who was our holder last year and is a backup quarterback for us. We of course also have a punter coming in this summer as part of our recruiting class in Tim Zaleski."

•Carl Granderson, Jr., DE: A torn ACL versus Air Force in the sixth game of the 2016 season brought Granderson's sophomore season to an end. Granderson was ranked No. 7 in the Mountain West in sacks entering the Air Force game. He was leading the Cowboys in both sacks (4.0 total sacks) and tackles for loss (6.0 total TFLs), entering the Air Force game.

- •Trevor Meader, RSr., DE: Missed entire 2015 and 2016 seasons due to two separate knee injuries suffered prior to the last two seasons after transferring from Wayne State College in Nebraska.
- •Kellen Overstreet, RSo., RB: Overstreet suffered a knee injury in the 2015 season finale against UNLV, leading to offseason knee surgery. He also had offseason shoulder surgery following the 2015 season. He redshirted the 2016 season.
